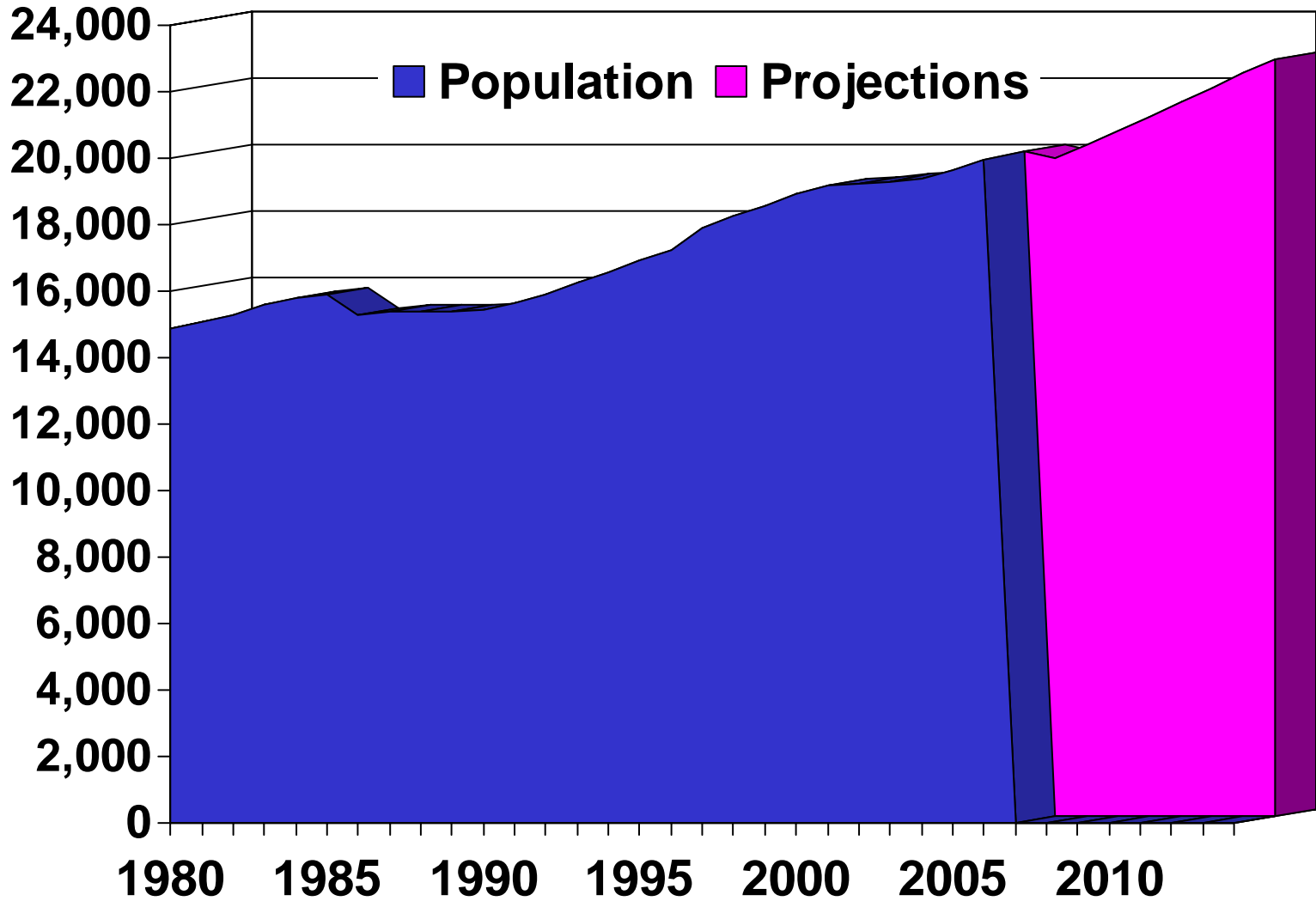

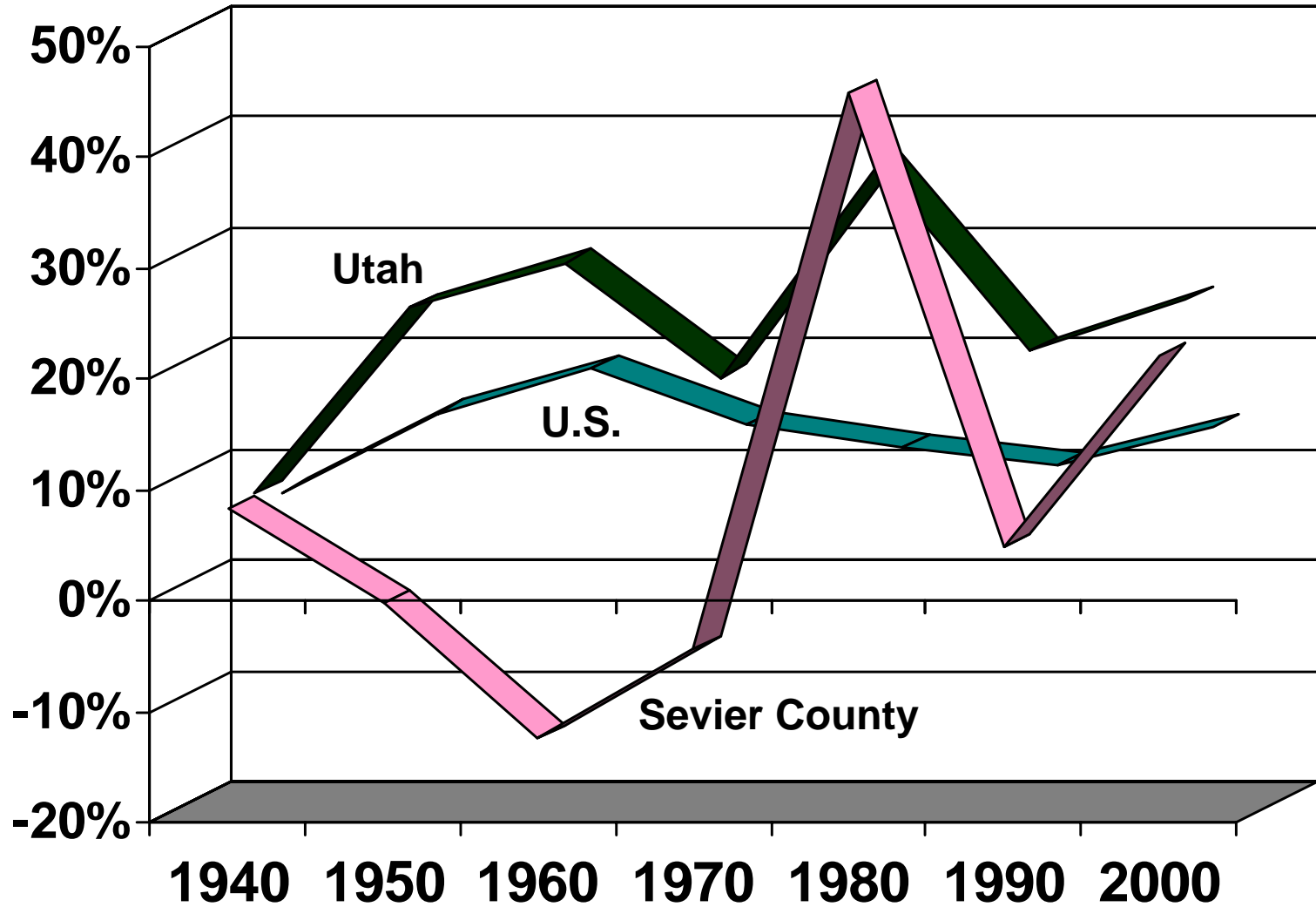

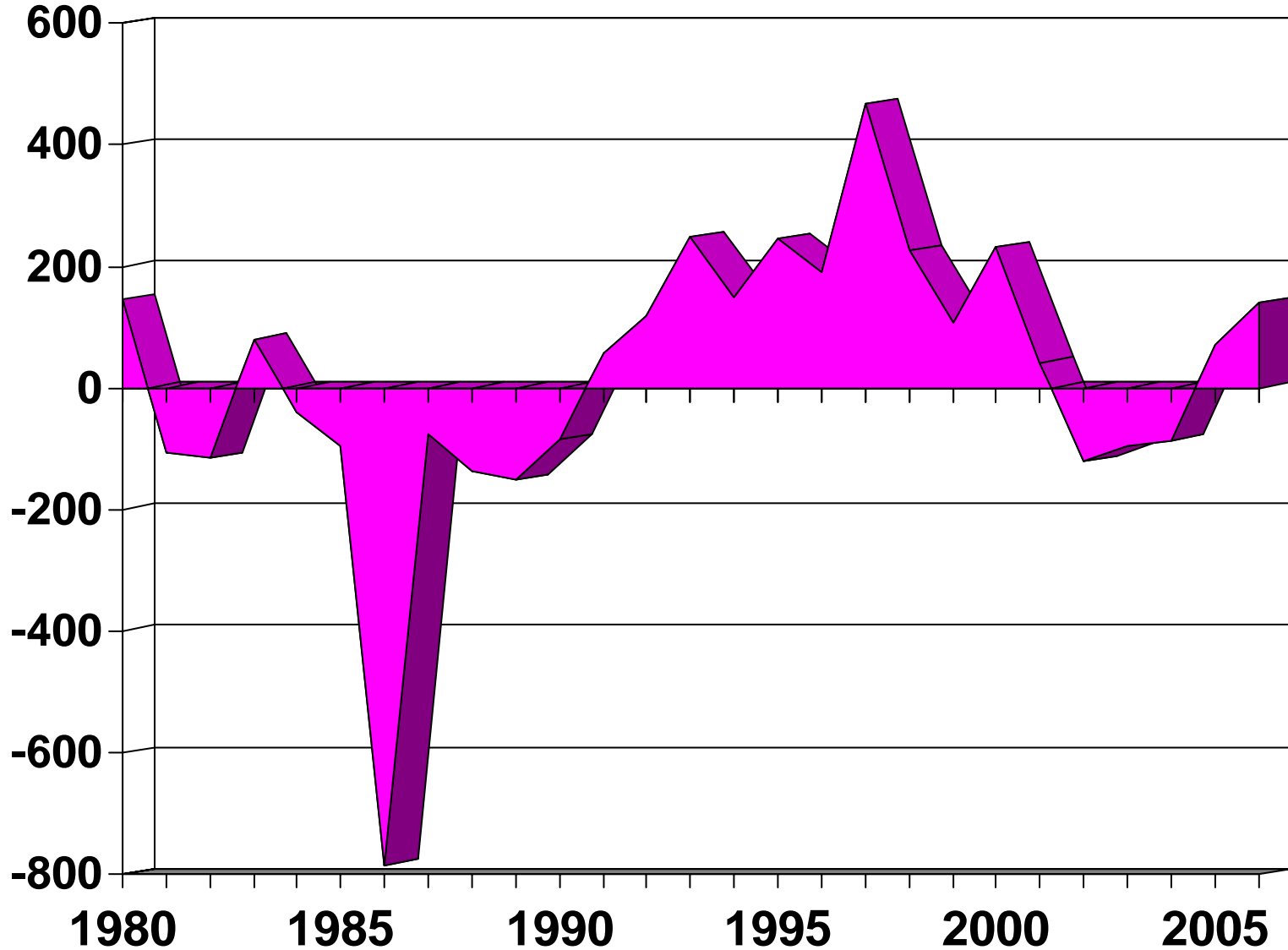

Population Growth

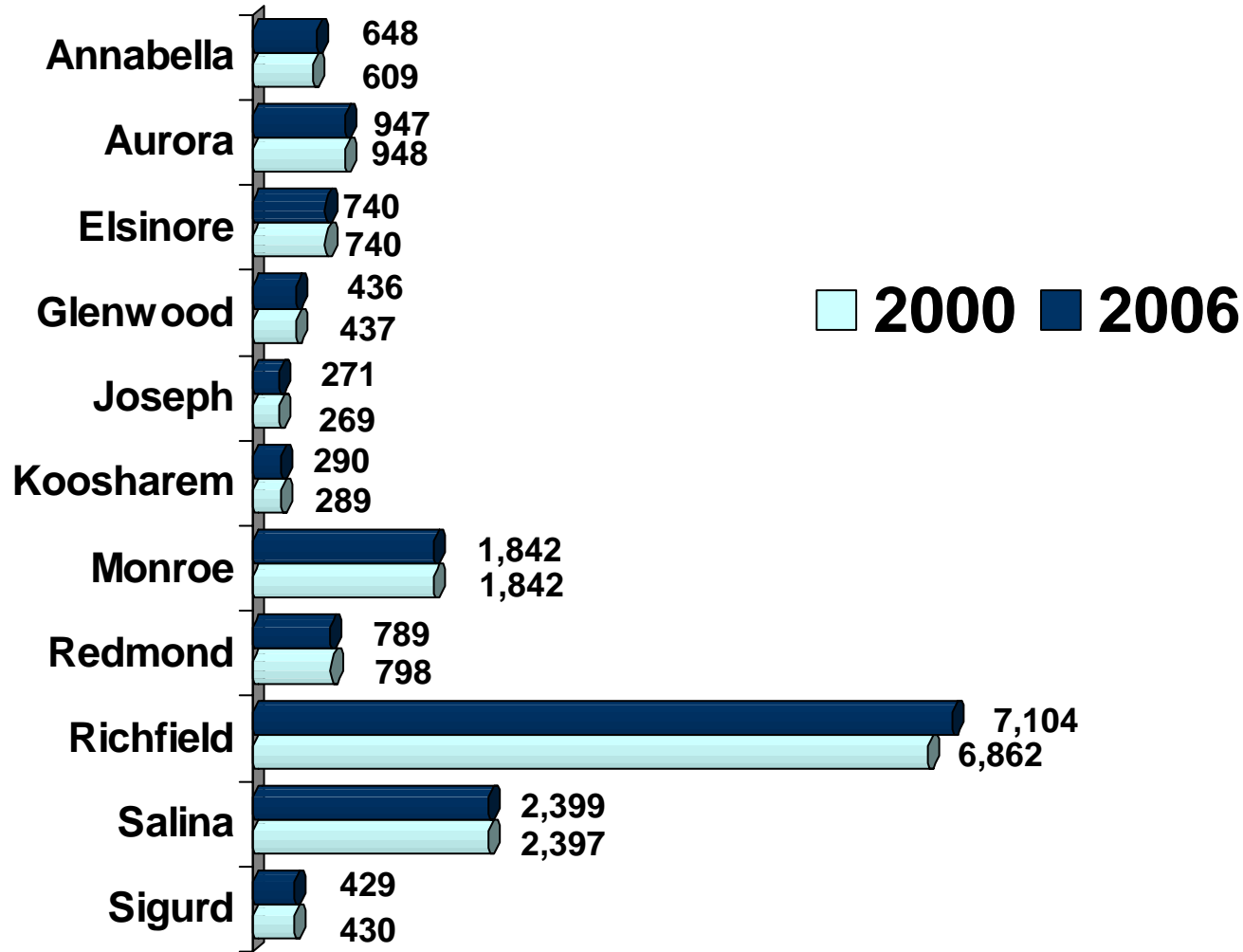


Sevier County Net Migration



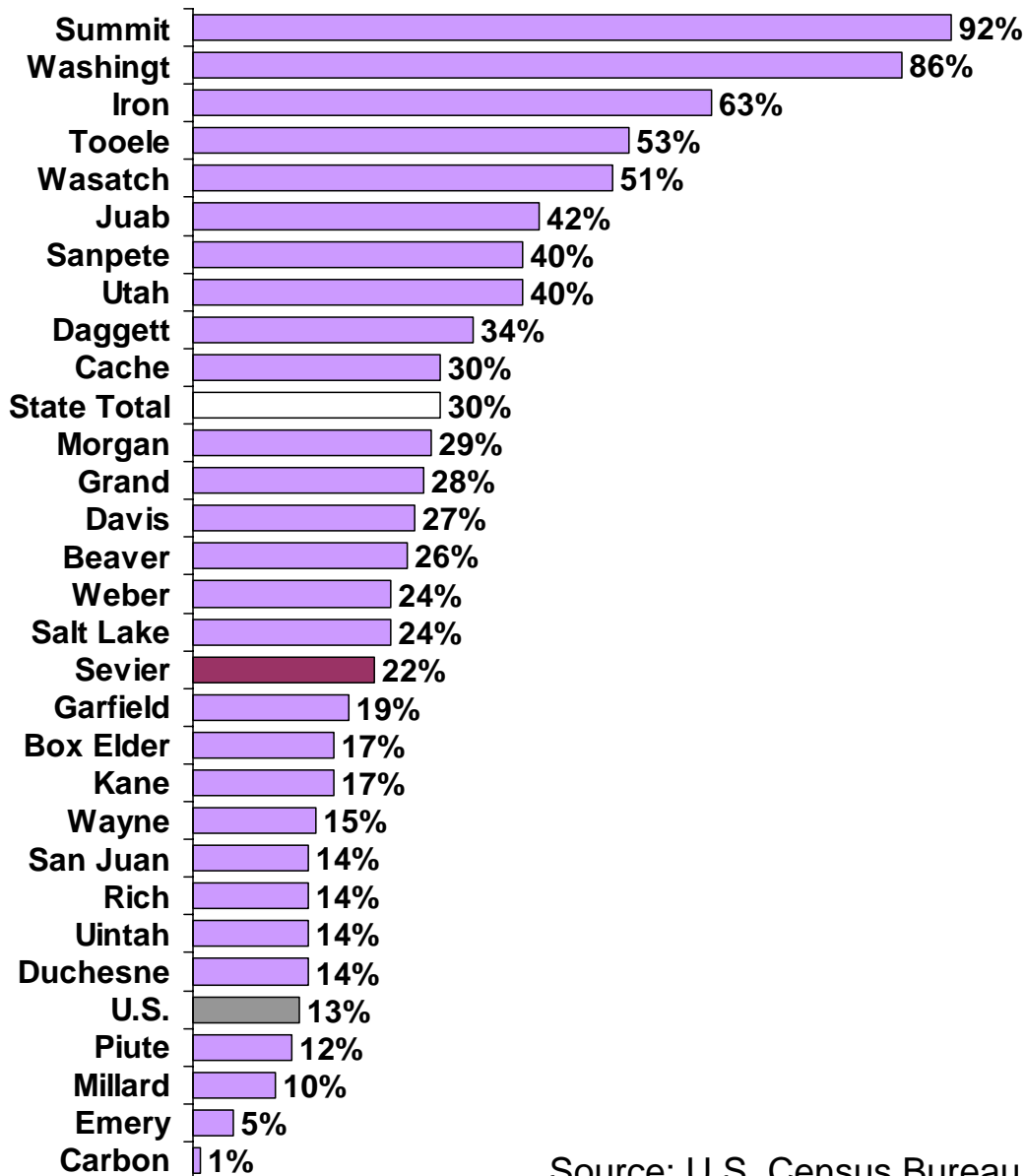

Sevier County Population by City



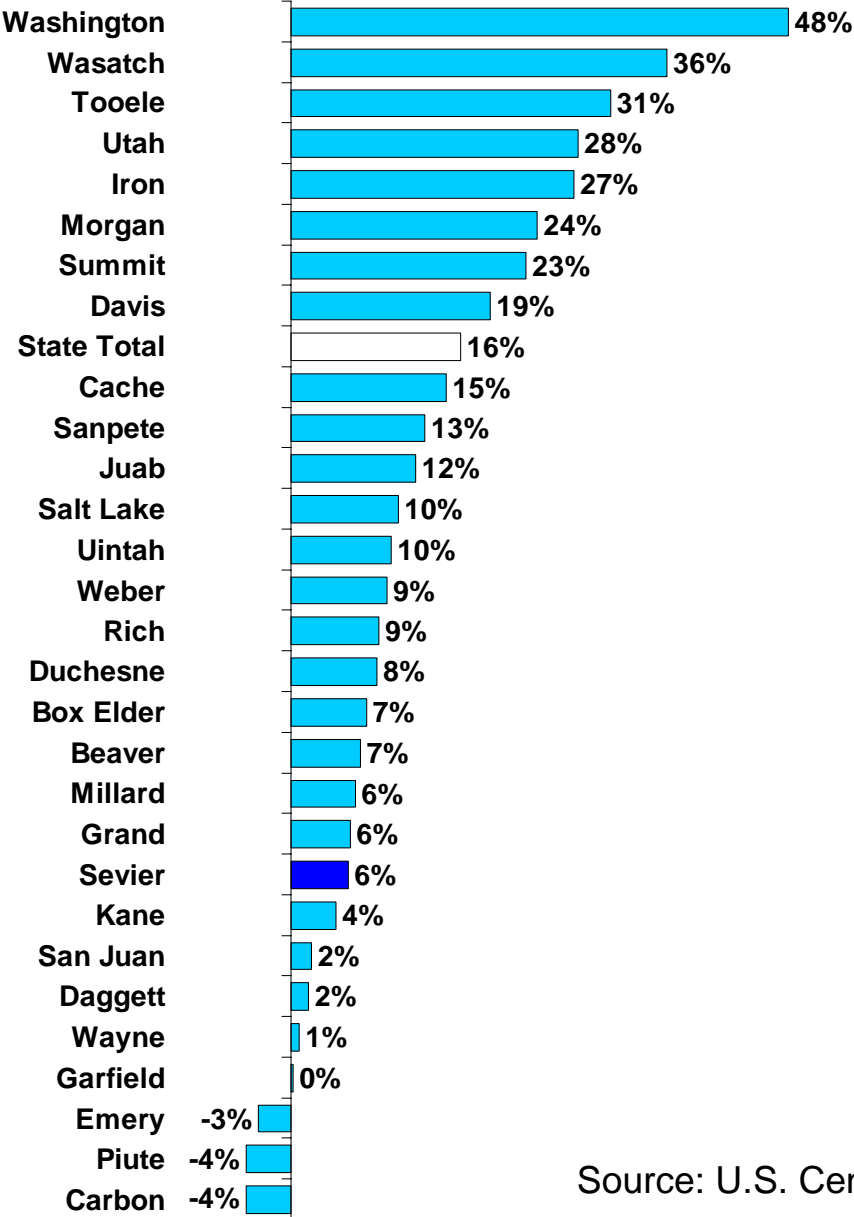

1990 to 2000 Population Growth by County



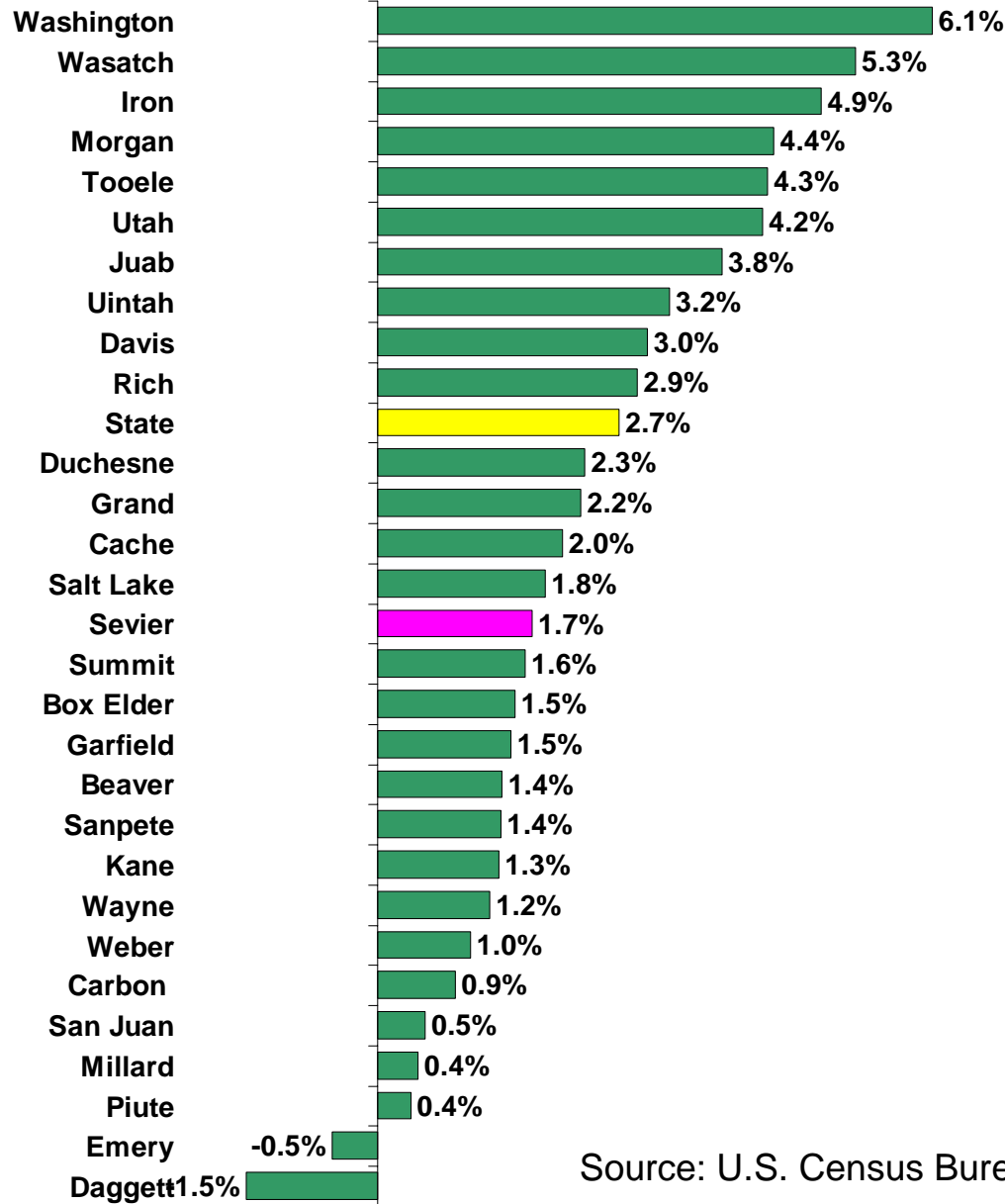

2000 to 2006 Population Growth by County



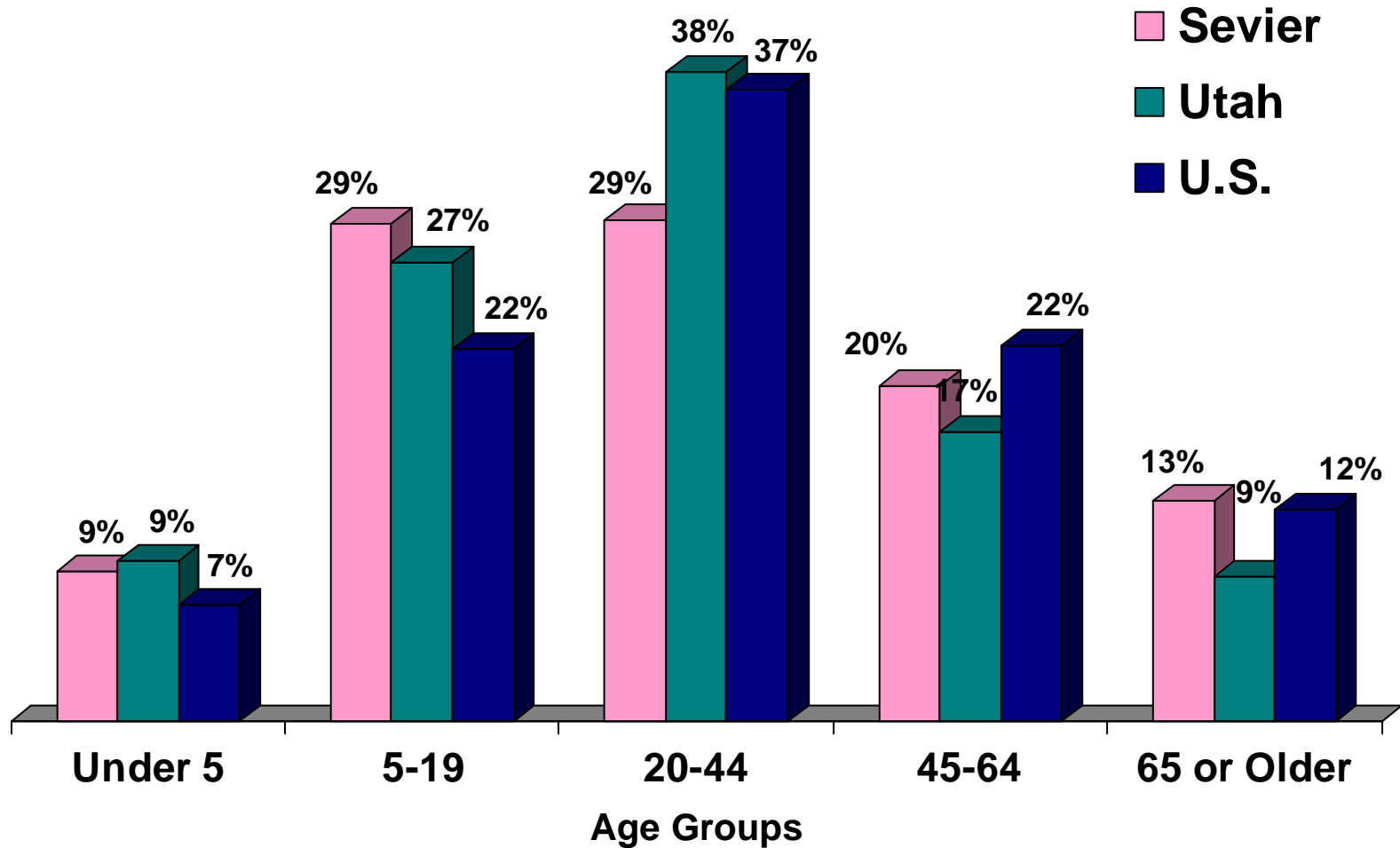

2005 to 2006 Population Growth by County

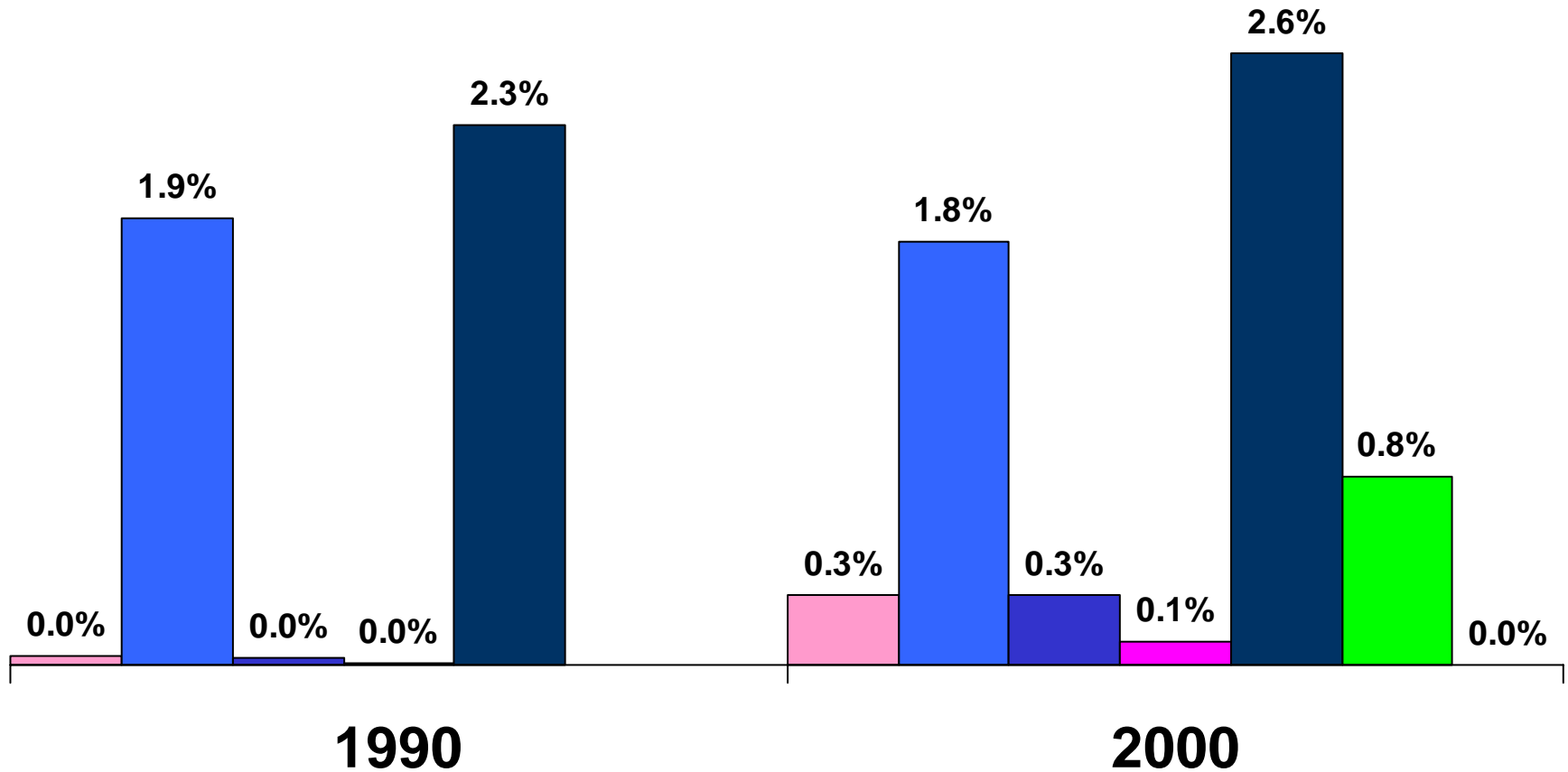

2000 Population Age Distribution

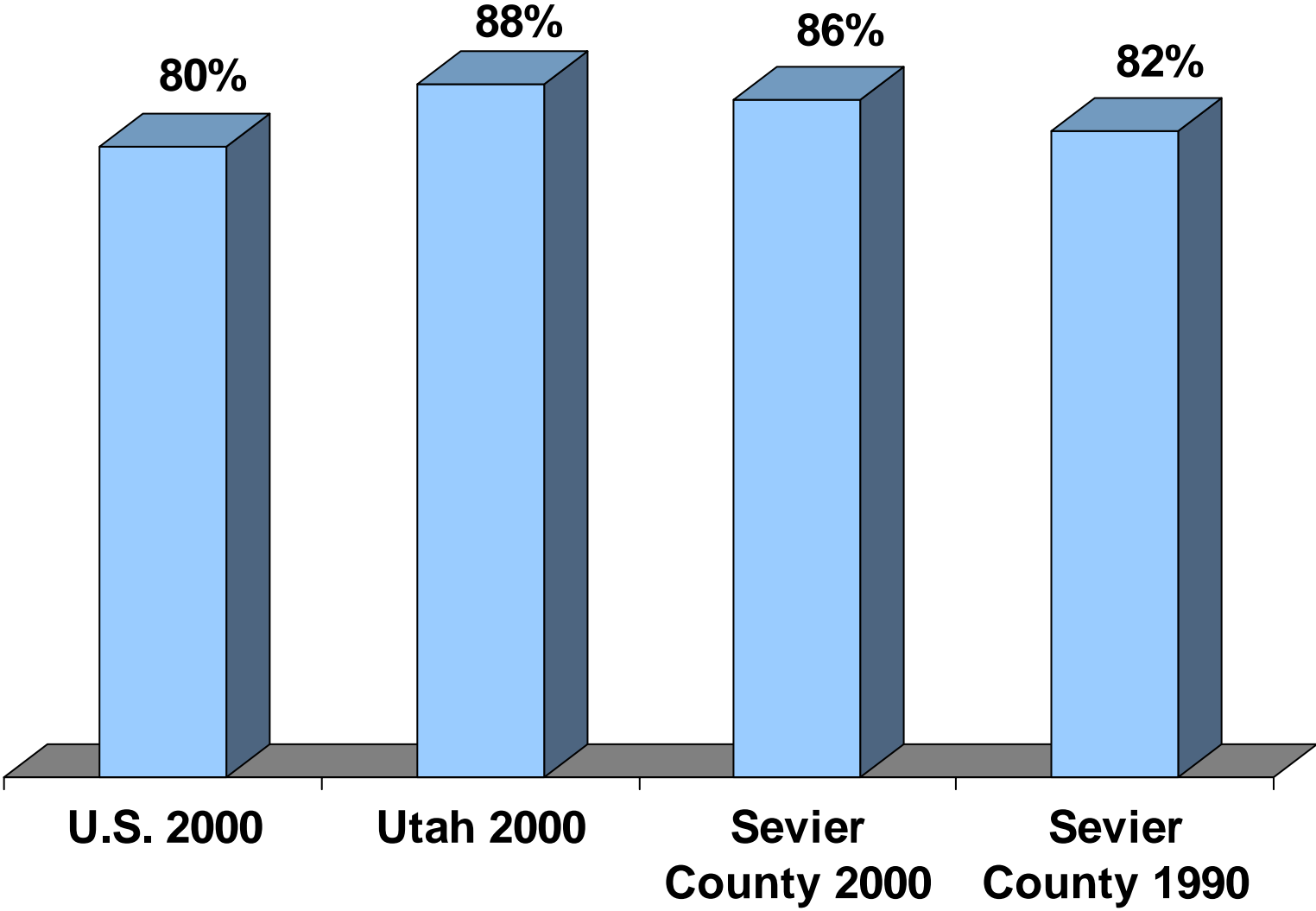


Sevier County Race/Ethnic Distribution



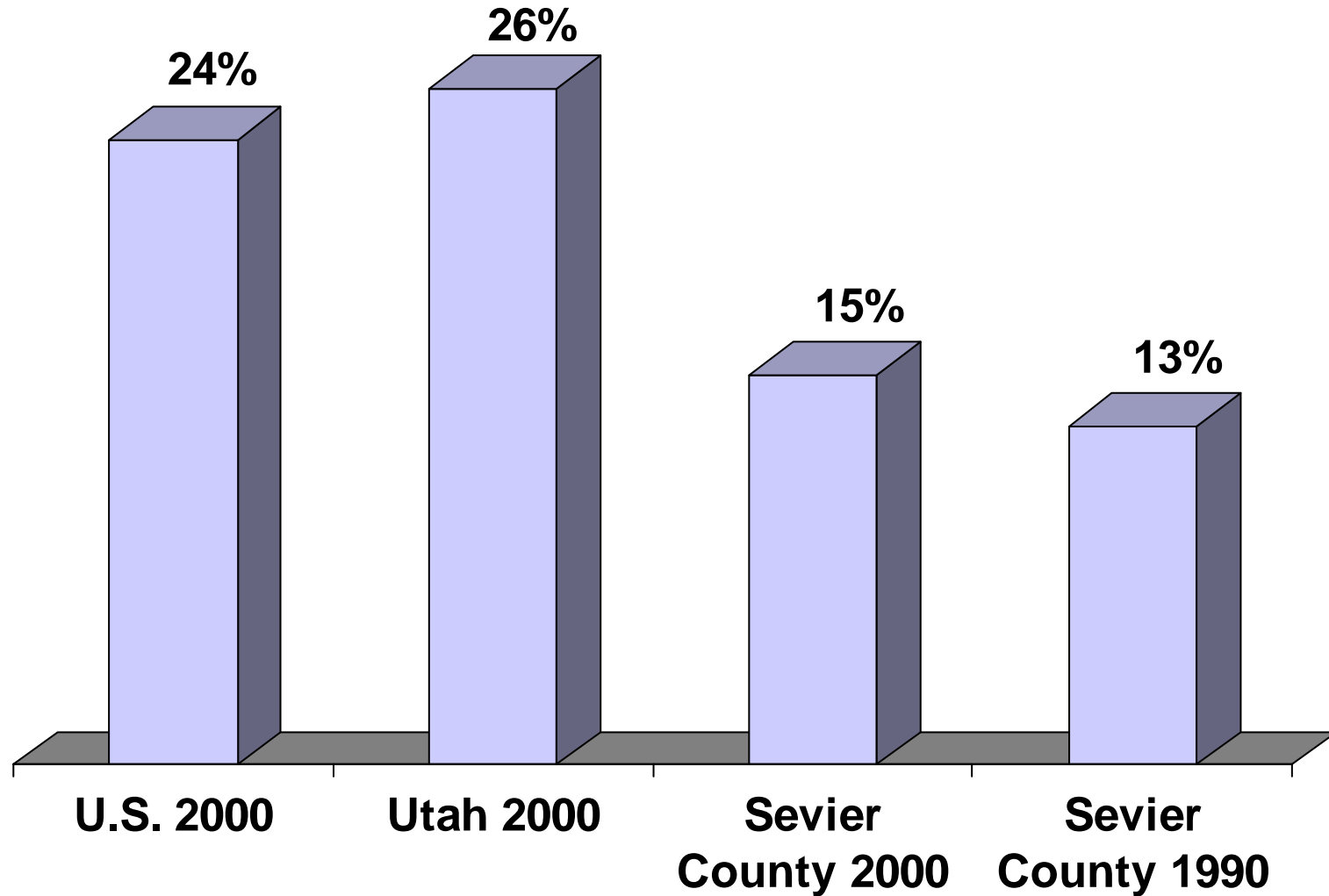

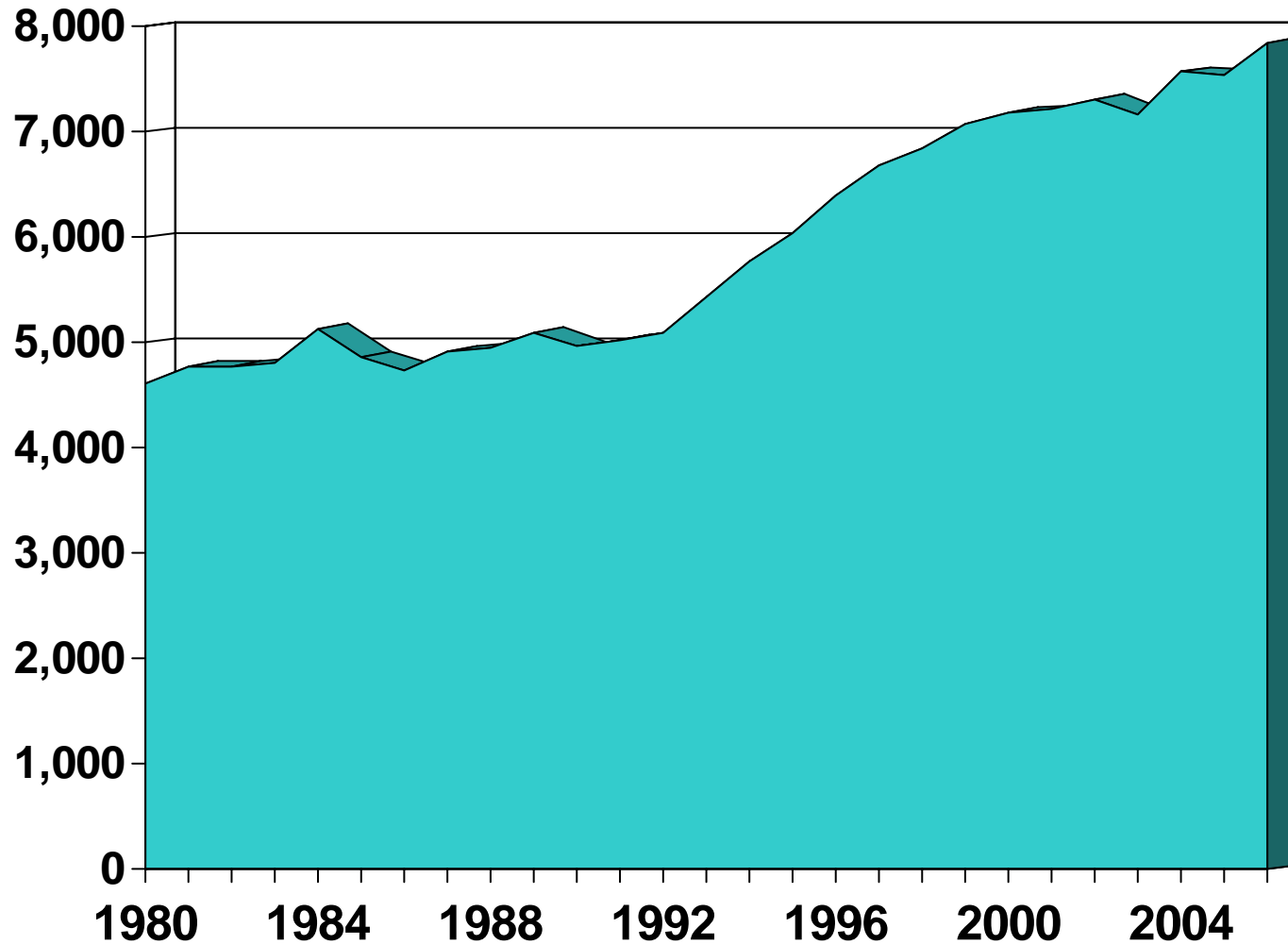

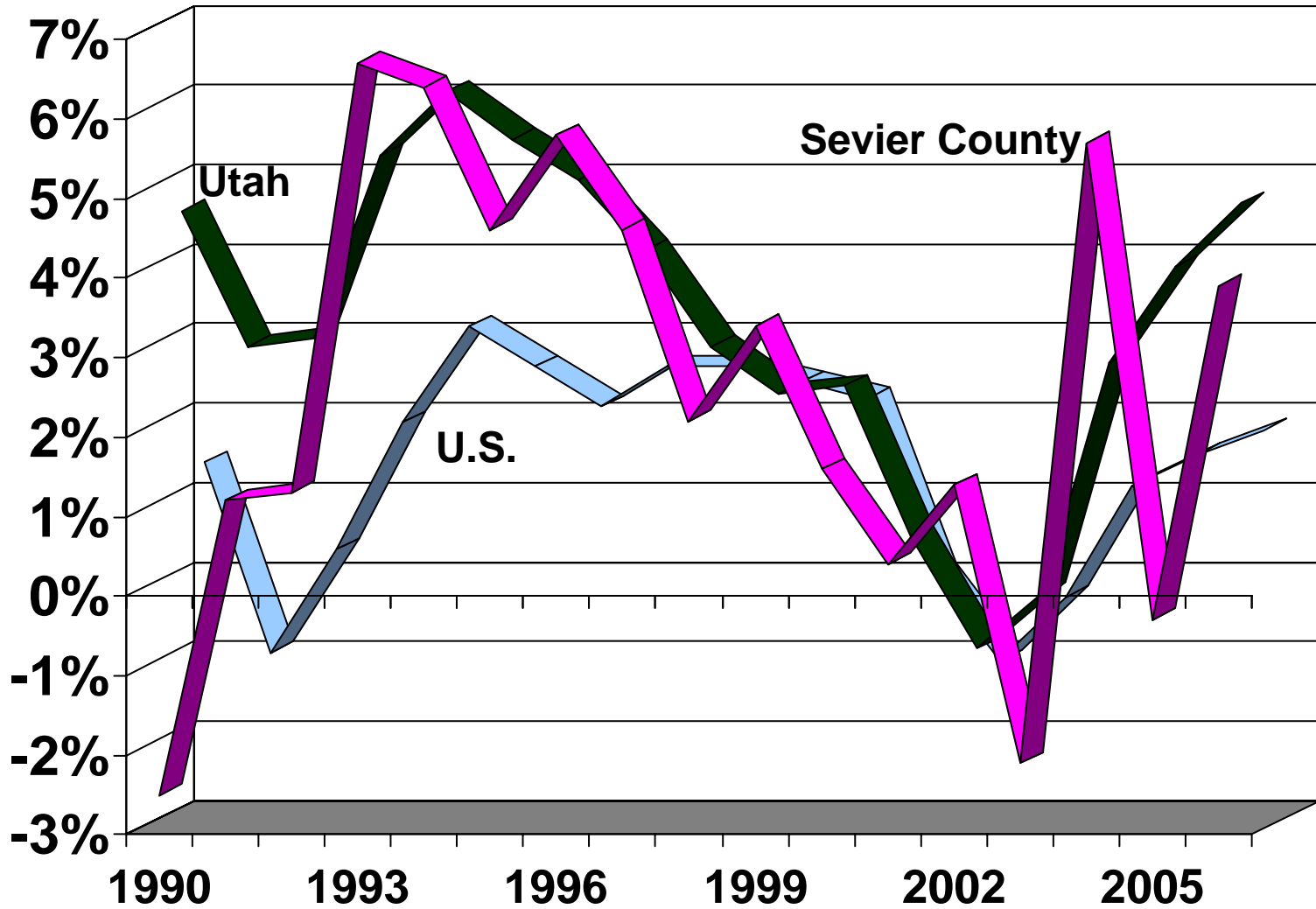


Sevier County Nonfarm Jobs



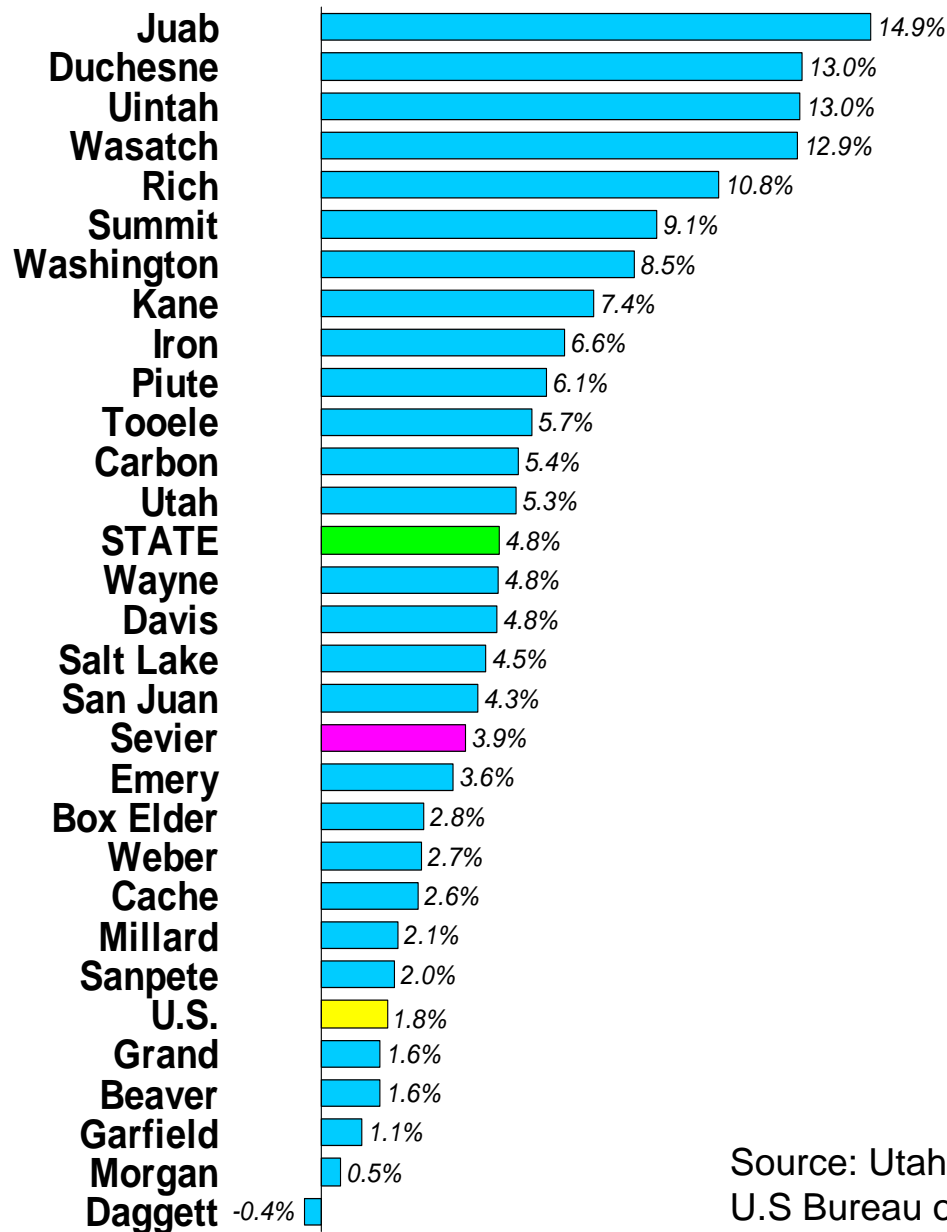

Nonfarm Job Growth



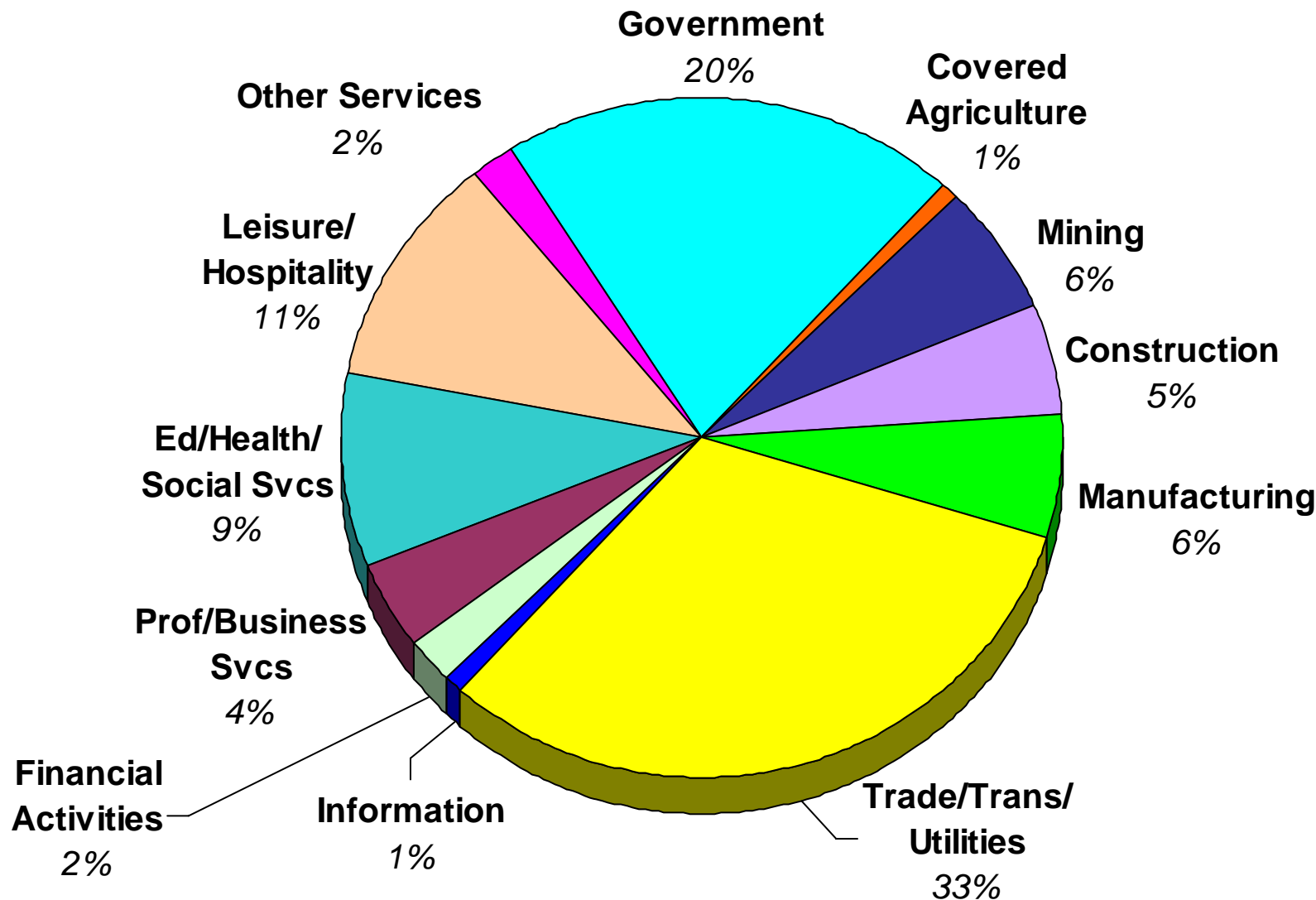

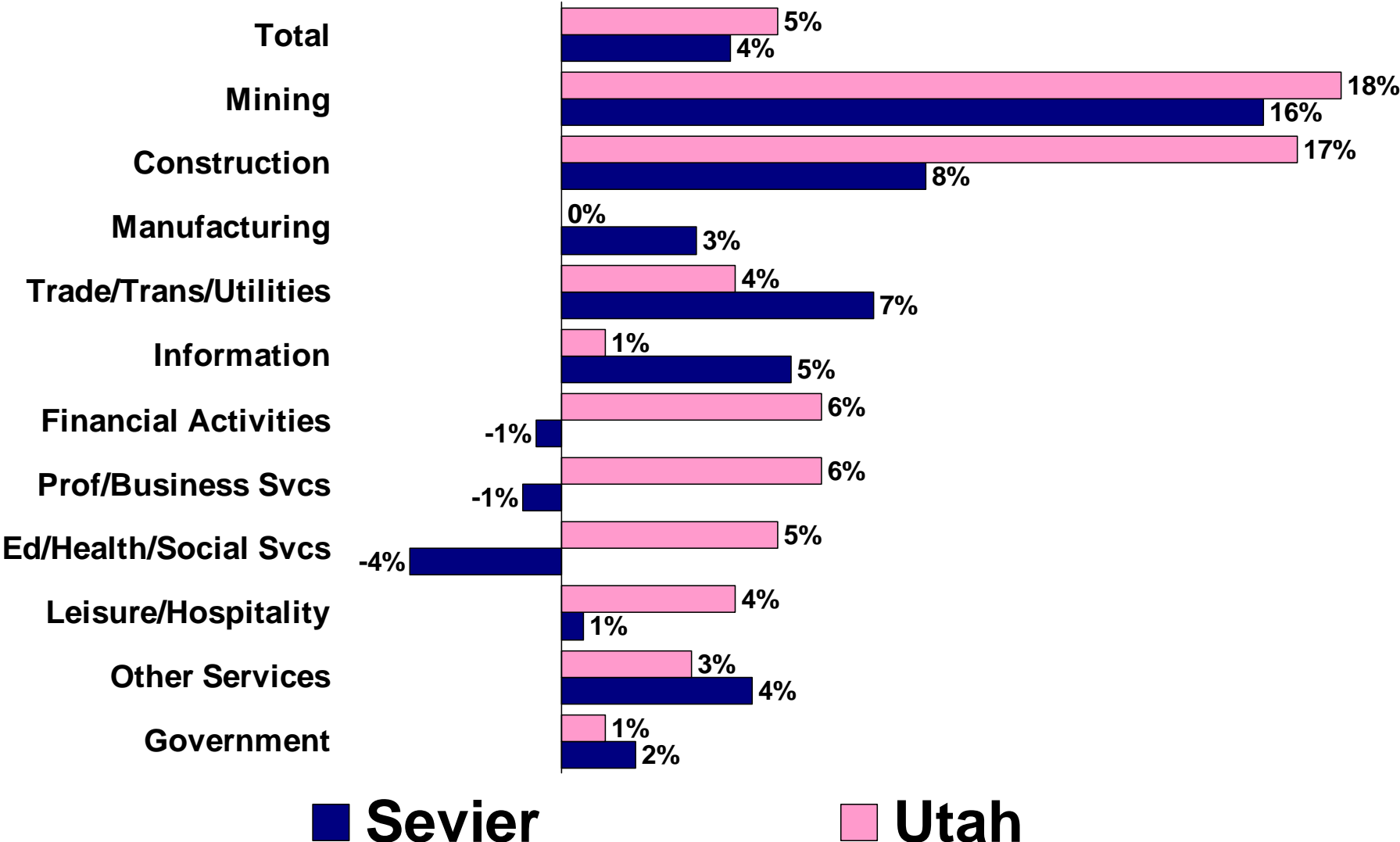
2006 Sevier County Jobs Distribution by Industry*

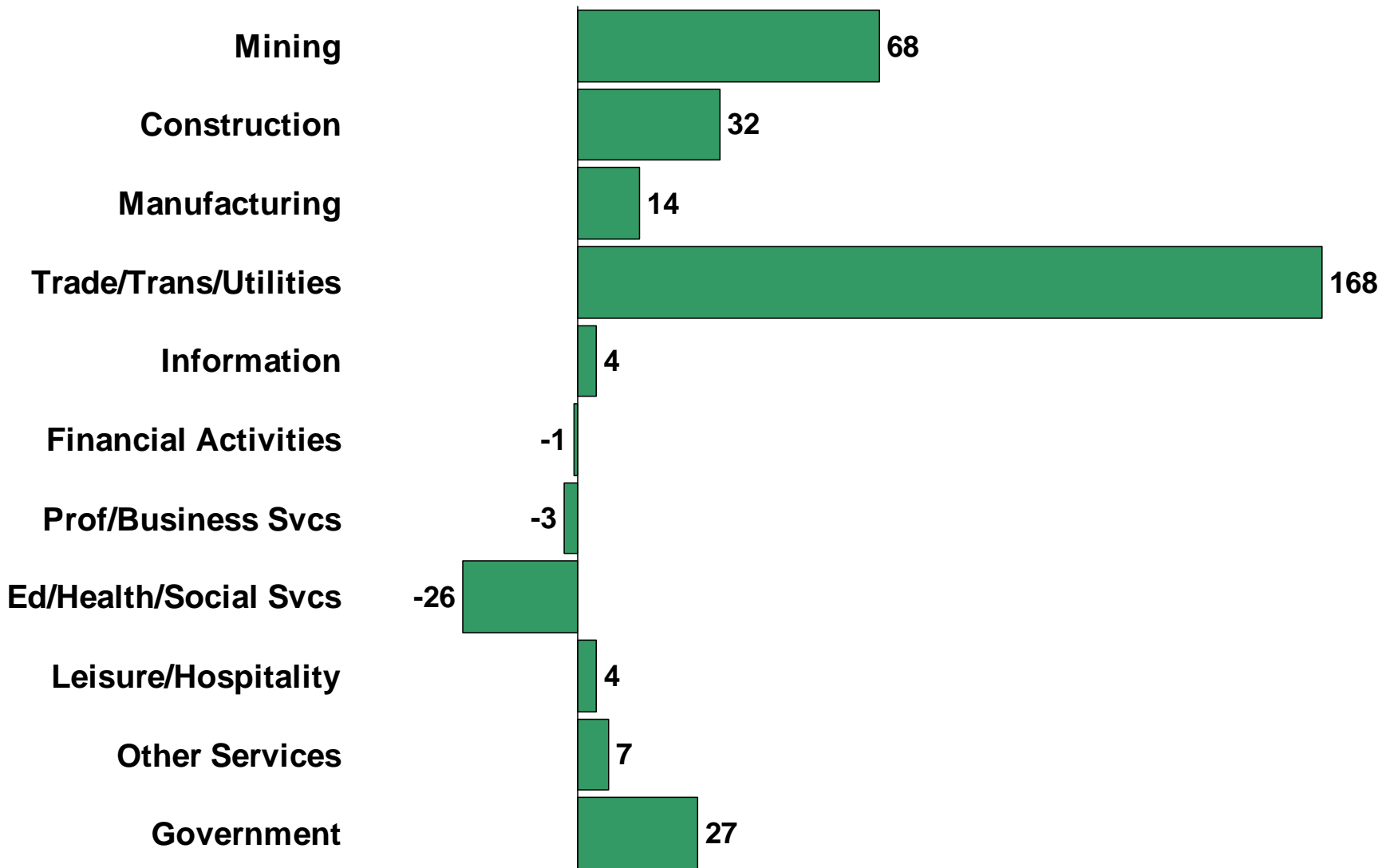

2006 Percent Change in Nonfarm Jobs by Industry



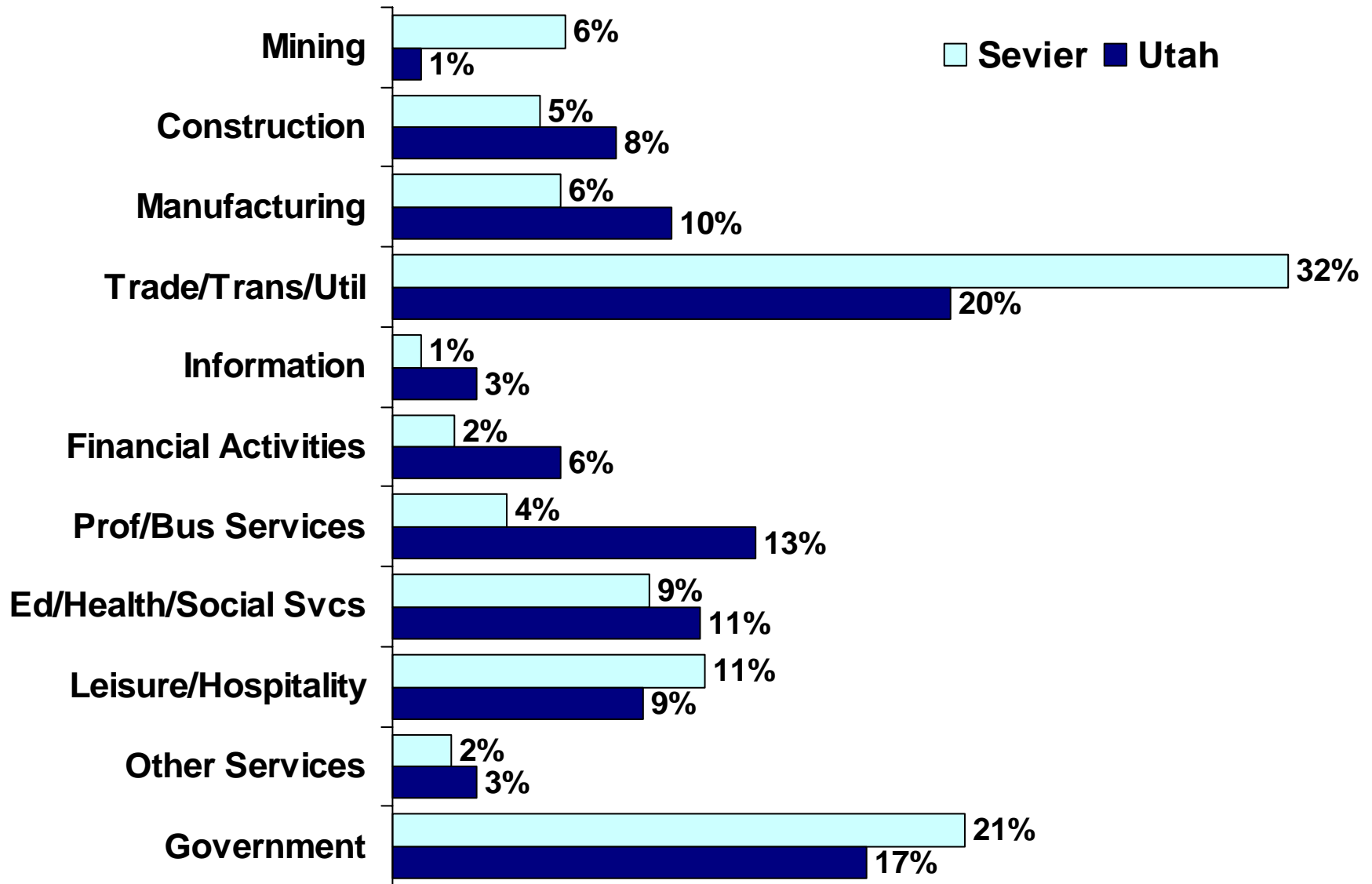

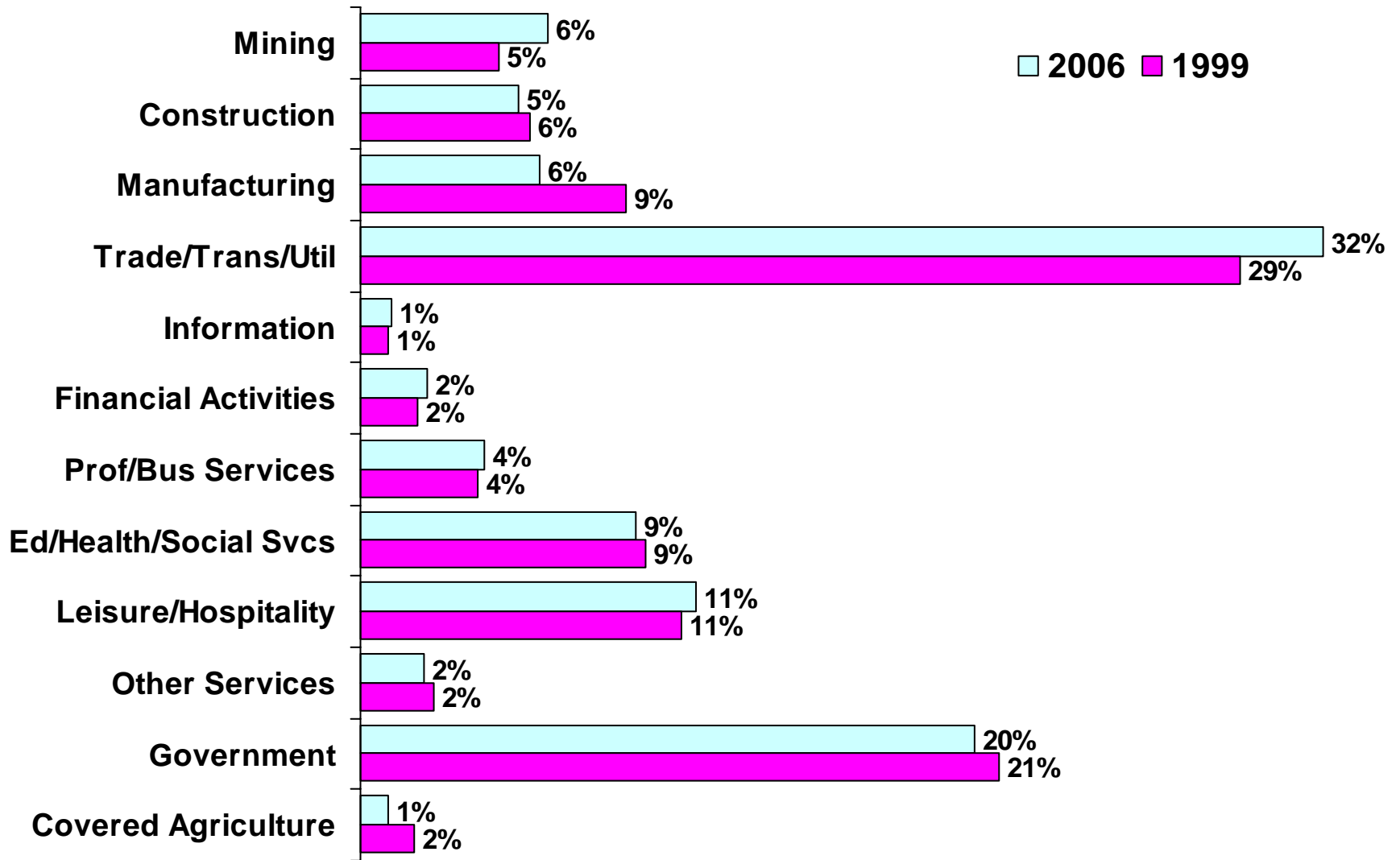
2006 Nonfarm Job Distribution by Industry*

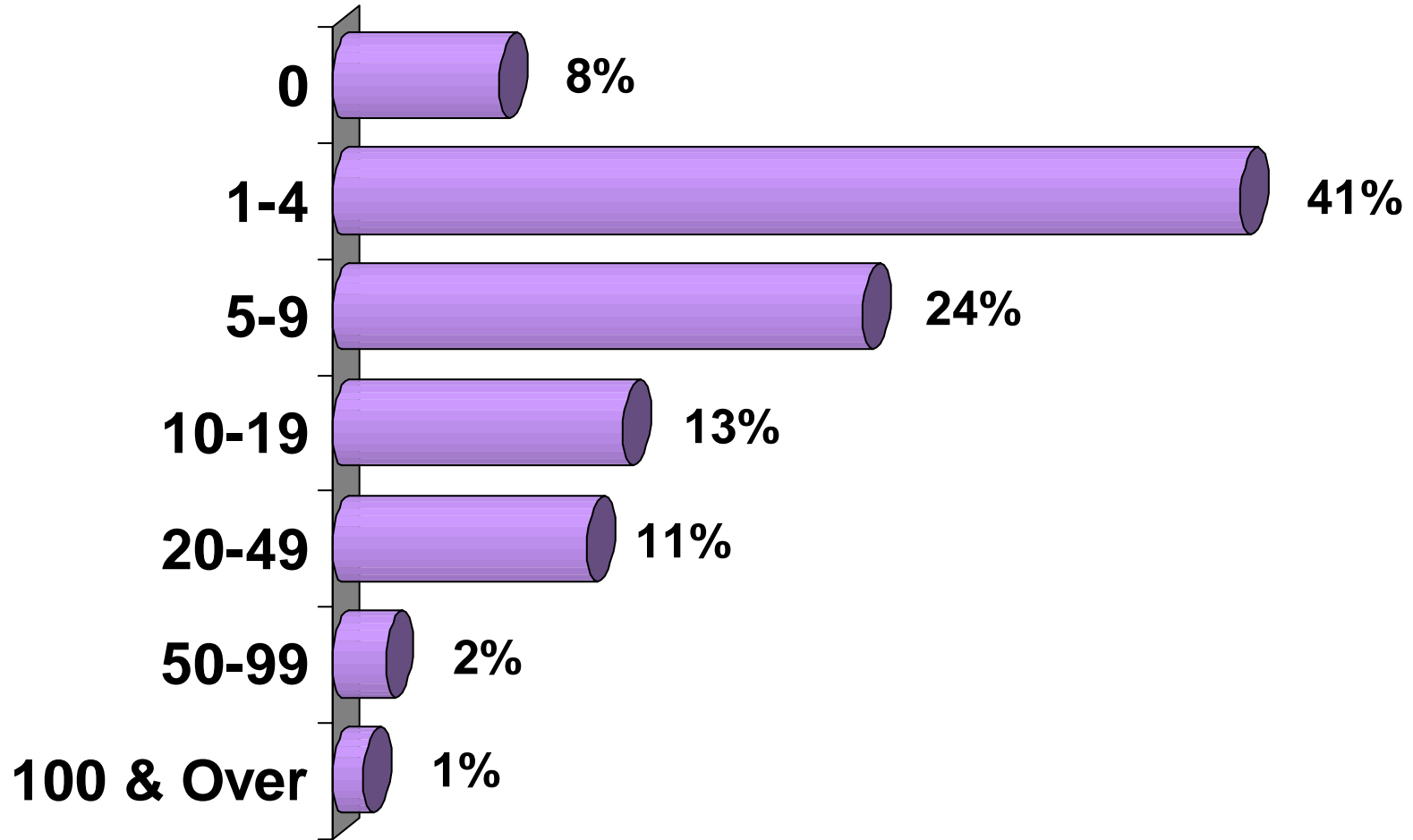
Sevier County Industrial Job Distribution*

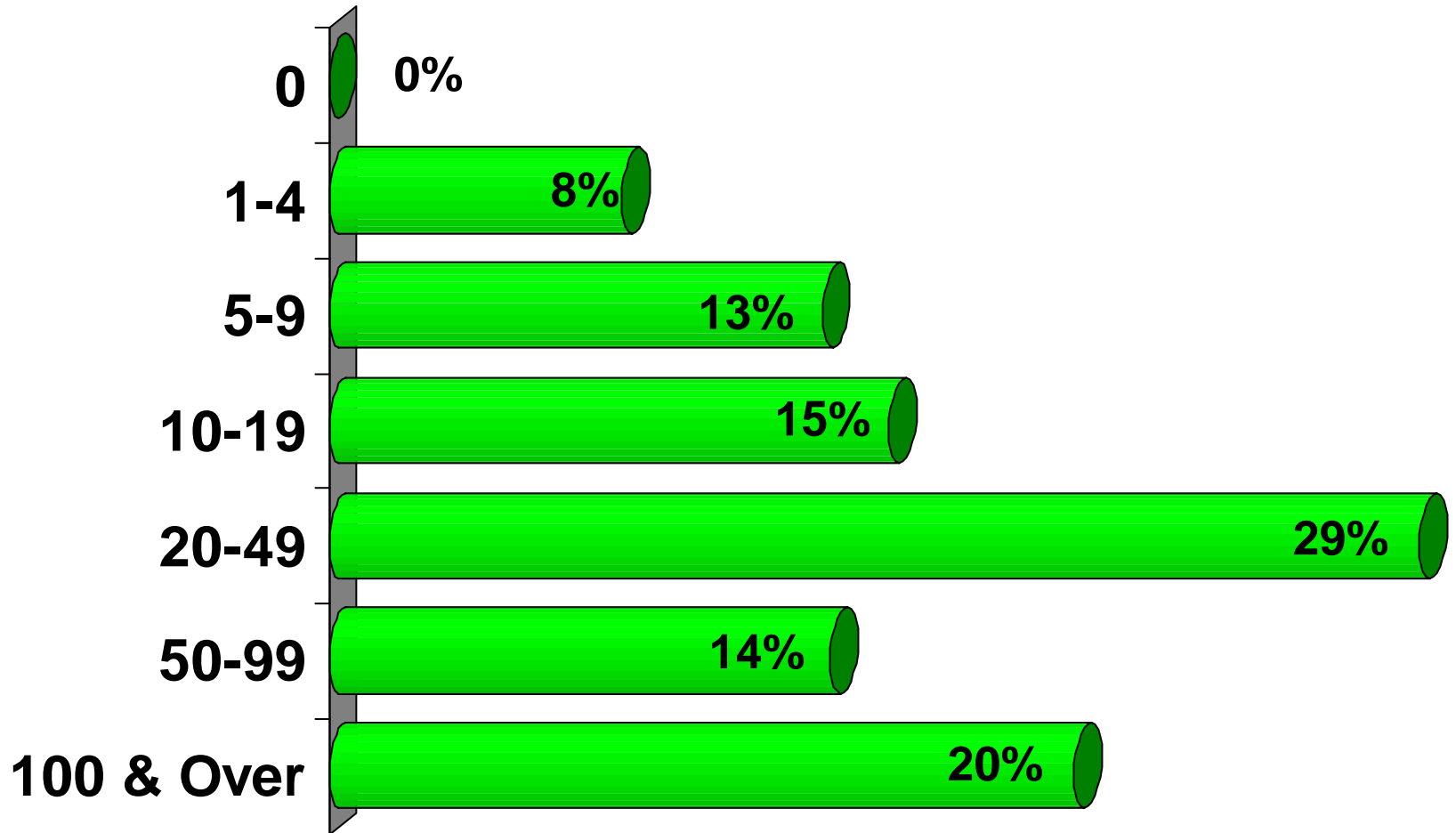

1st Qtr 2006 Sevier County Firms by Size



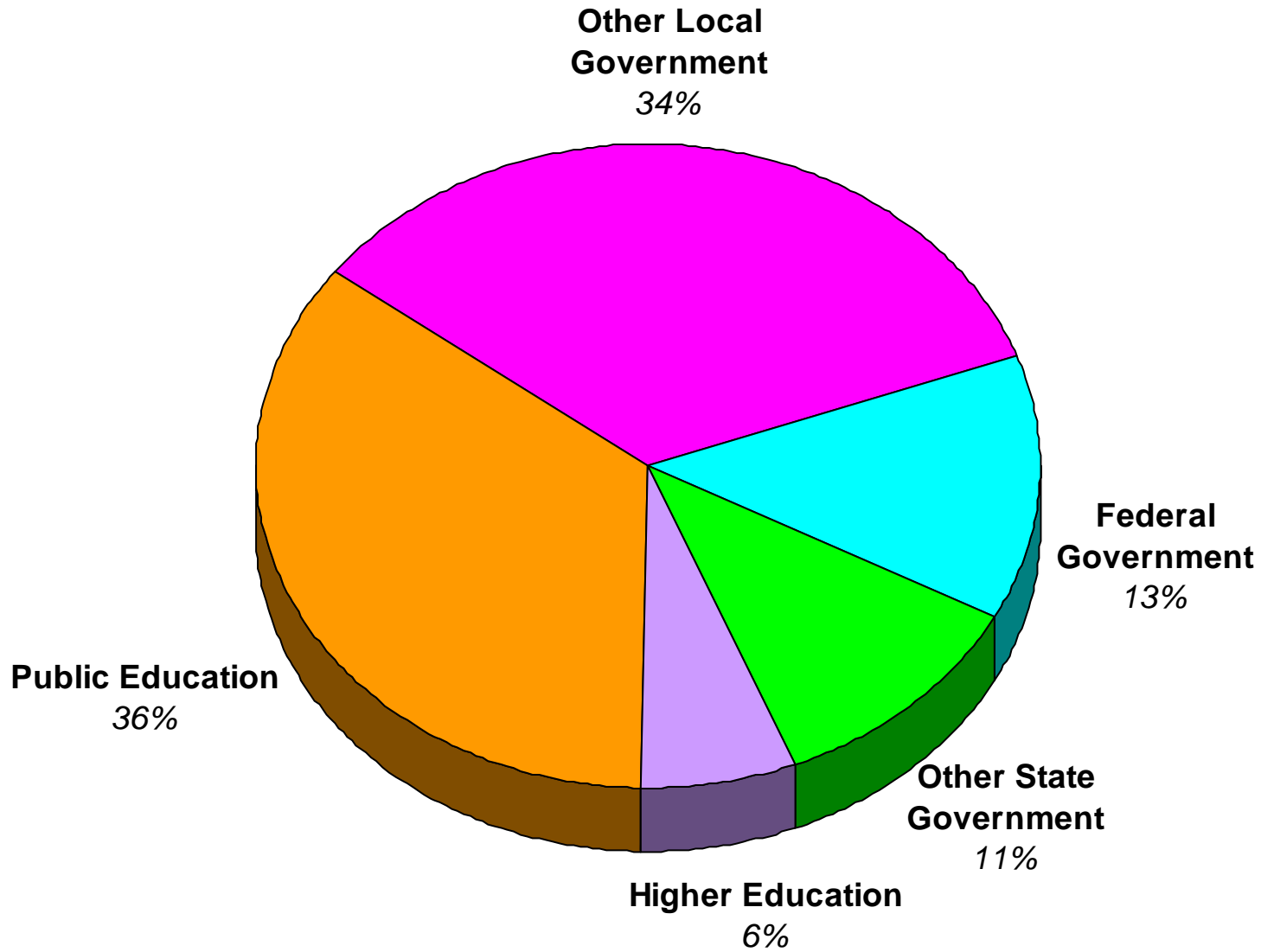

1st Qtr 2006 Sevier County Employment by Firm Size



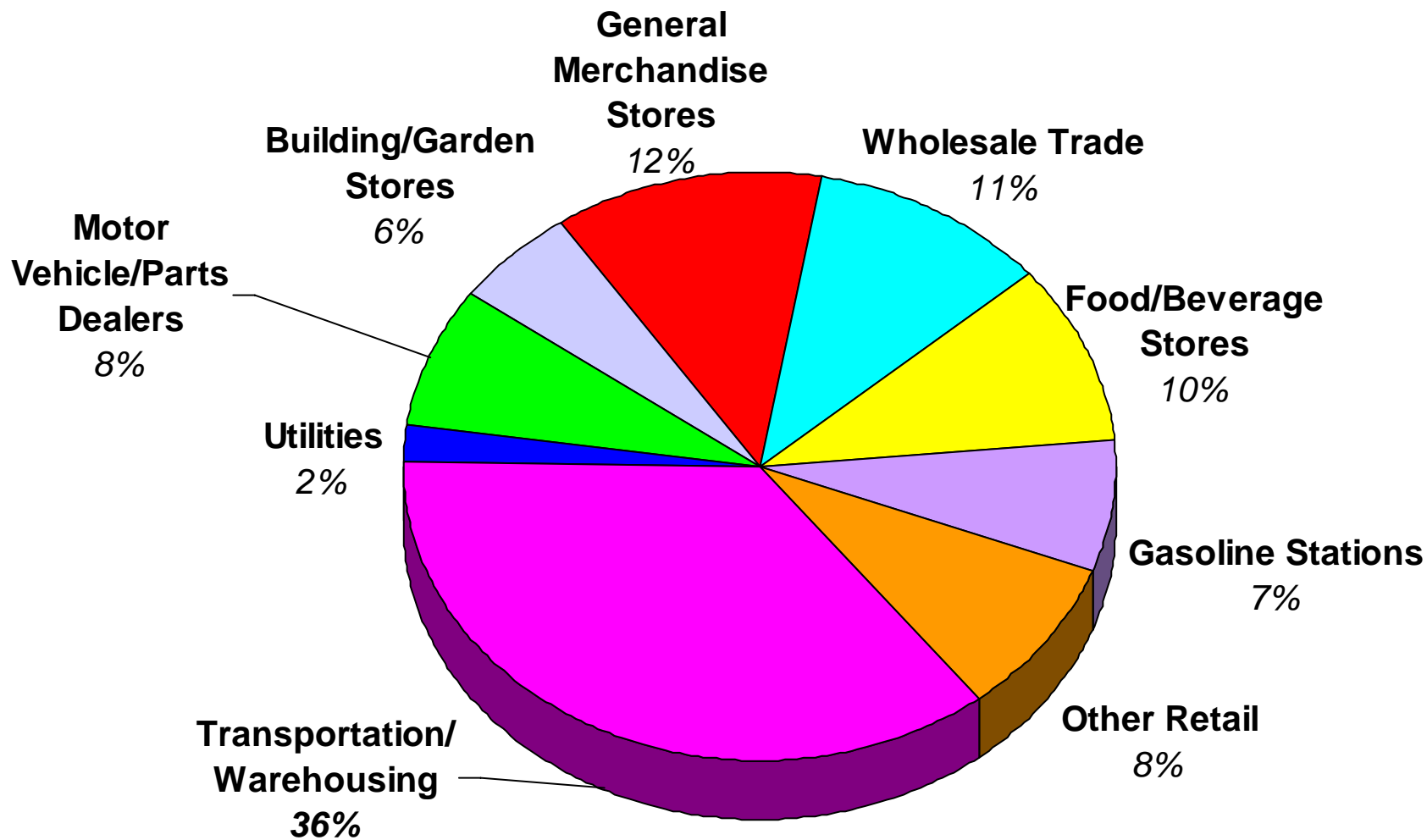

2006 Sevier County Government



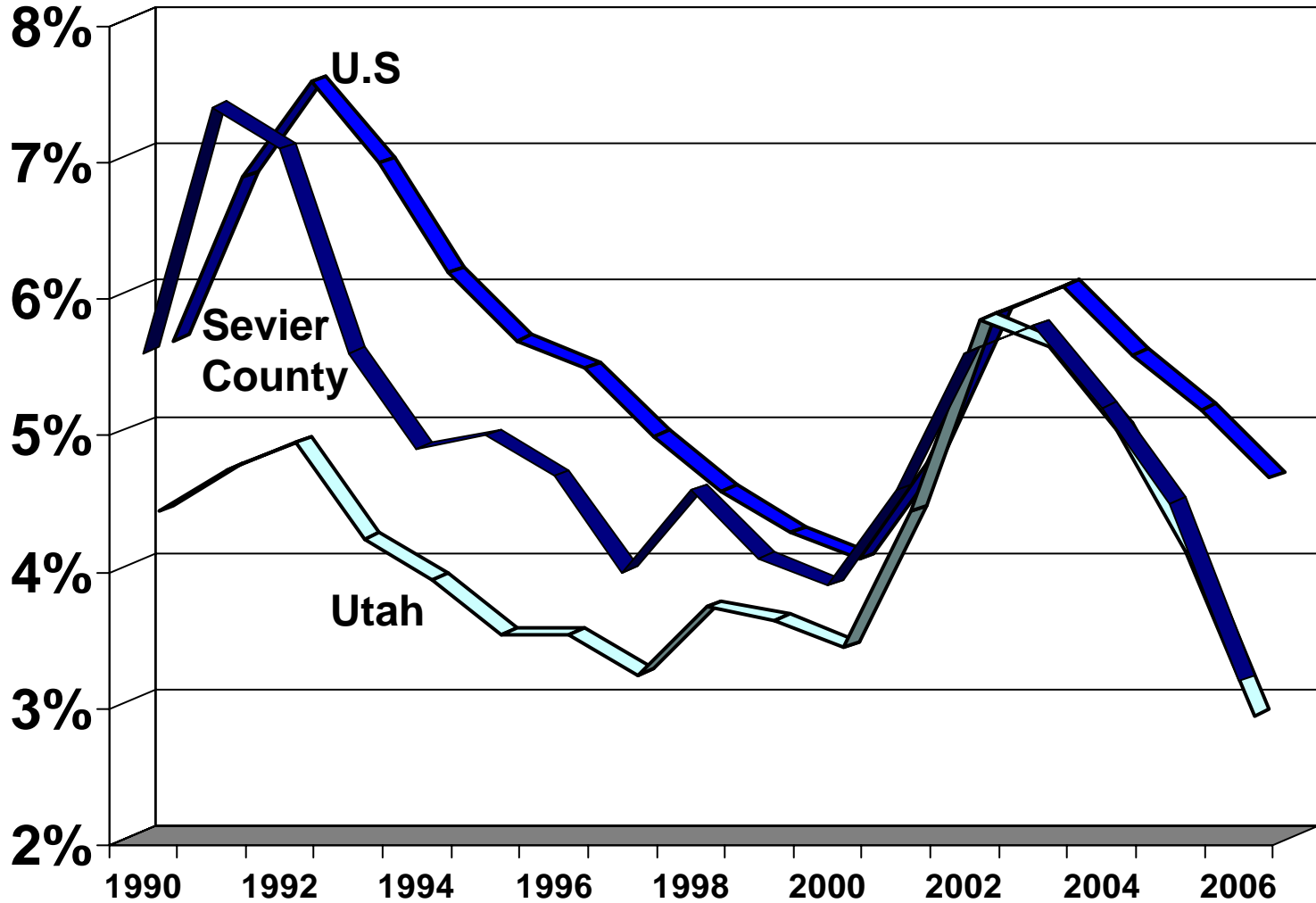

2006 Sevier County Trade/Transportation/Utilities



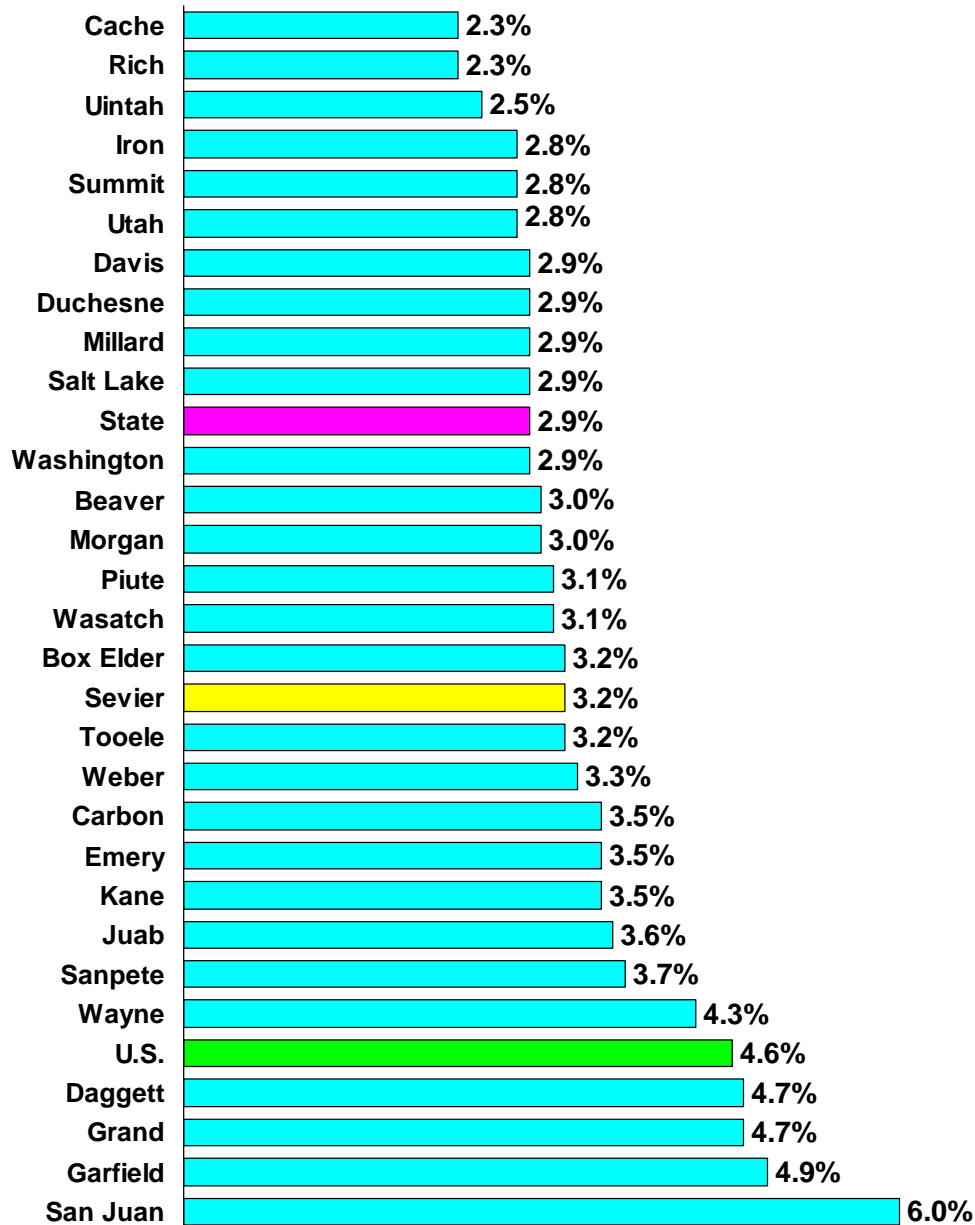

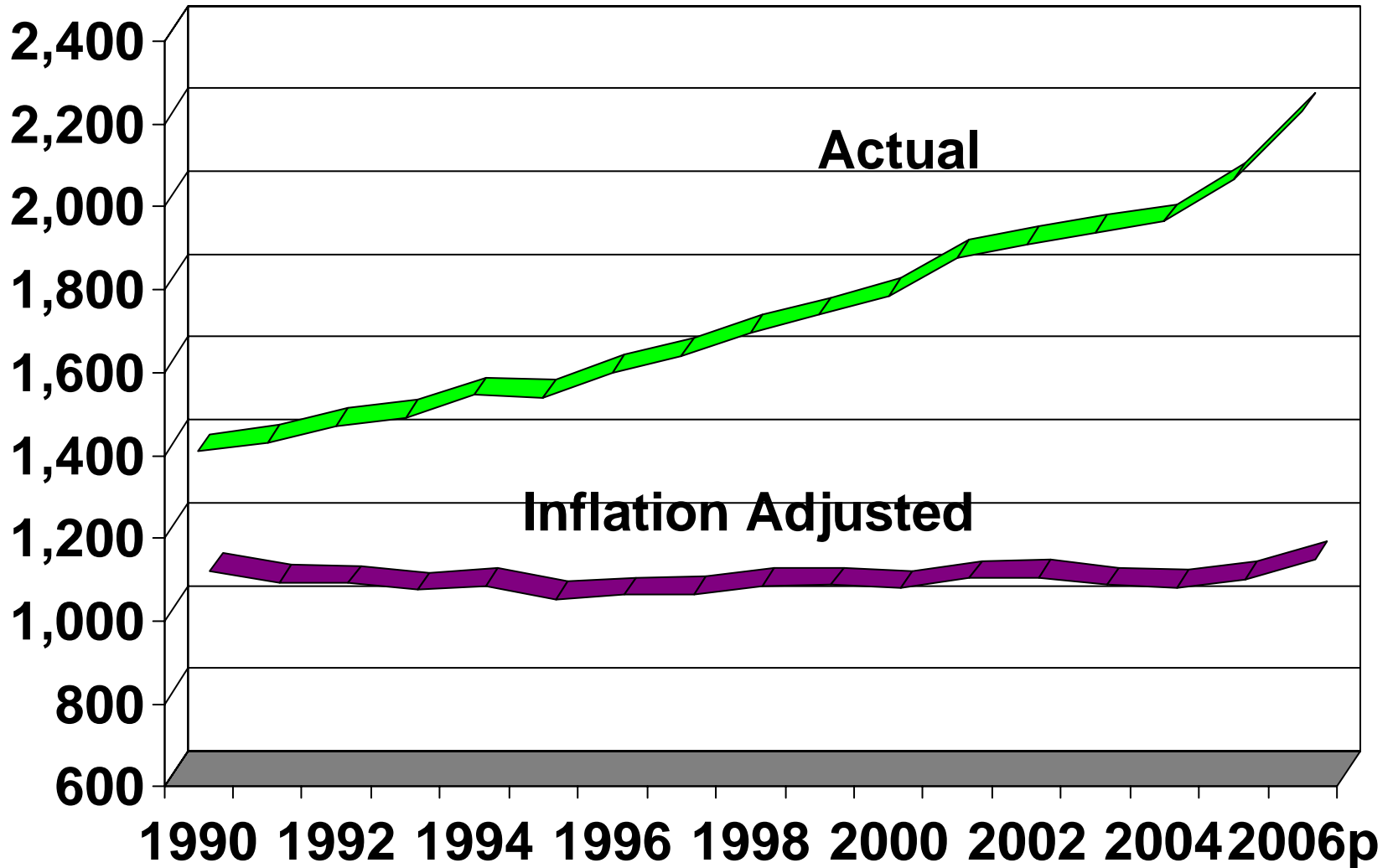

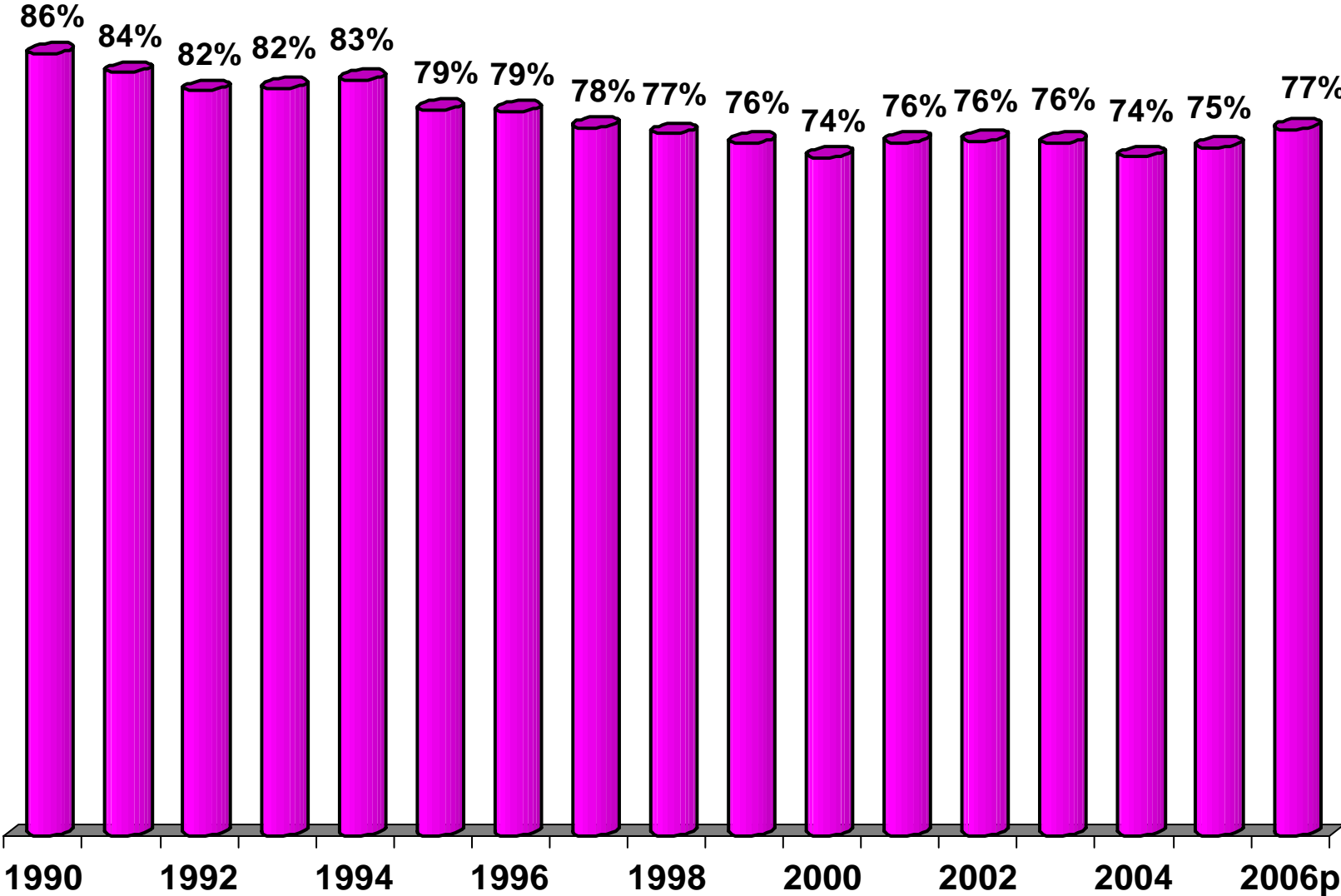


Sevier County Average Monthly Wage



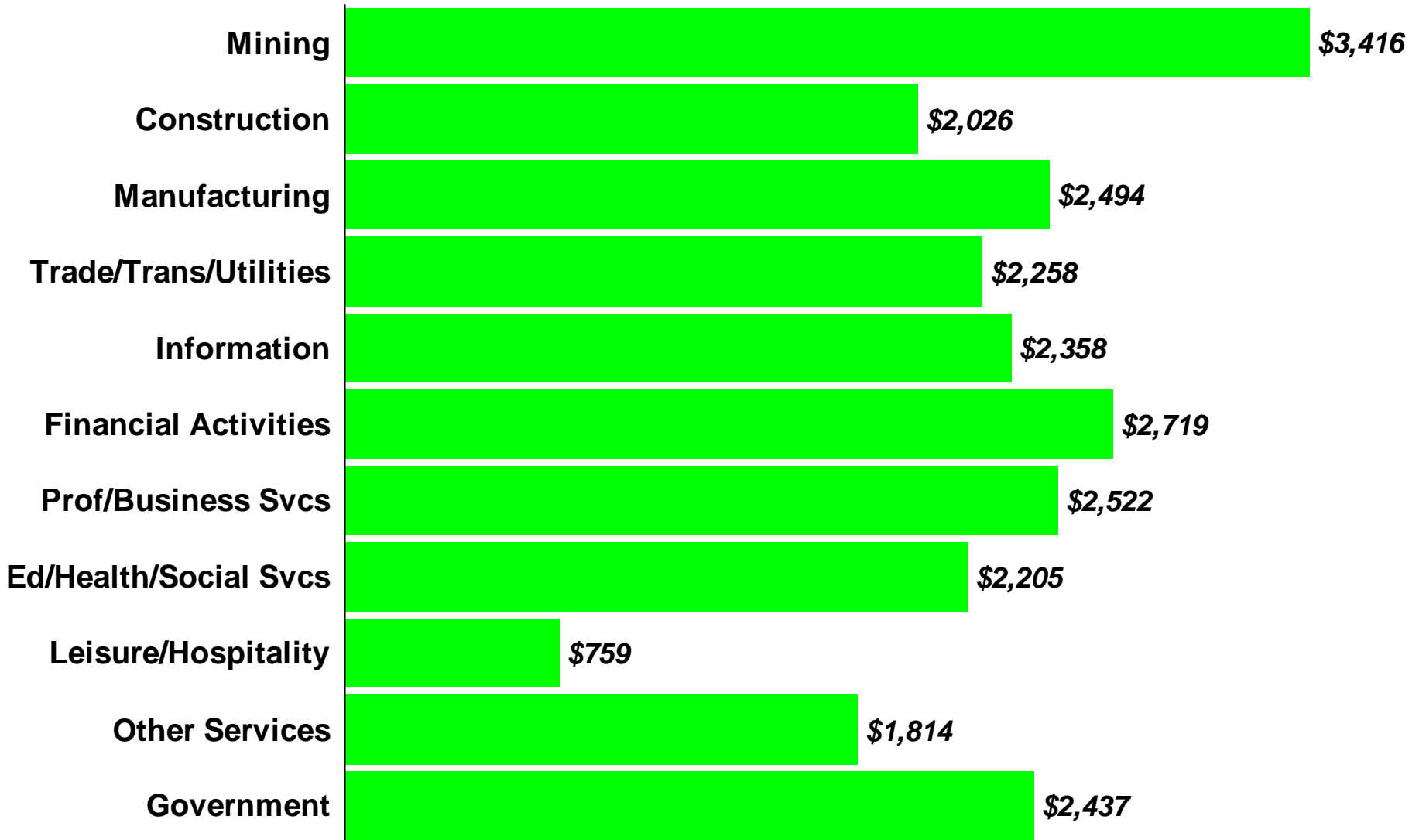

Sevier County Average Monthly Wage as a Percent of State



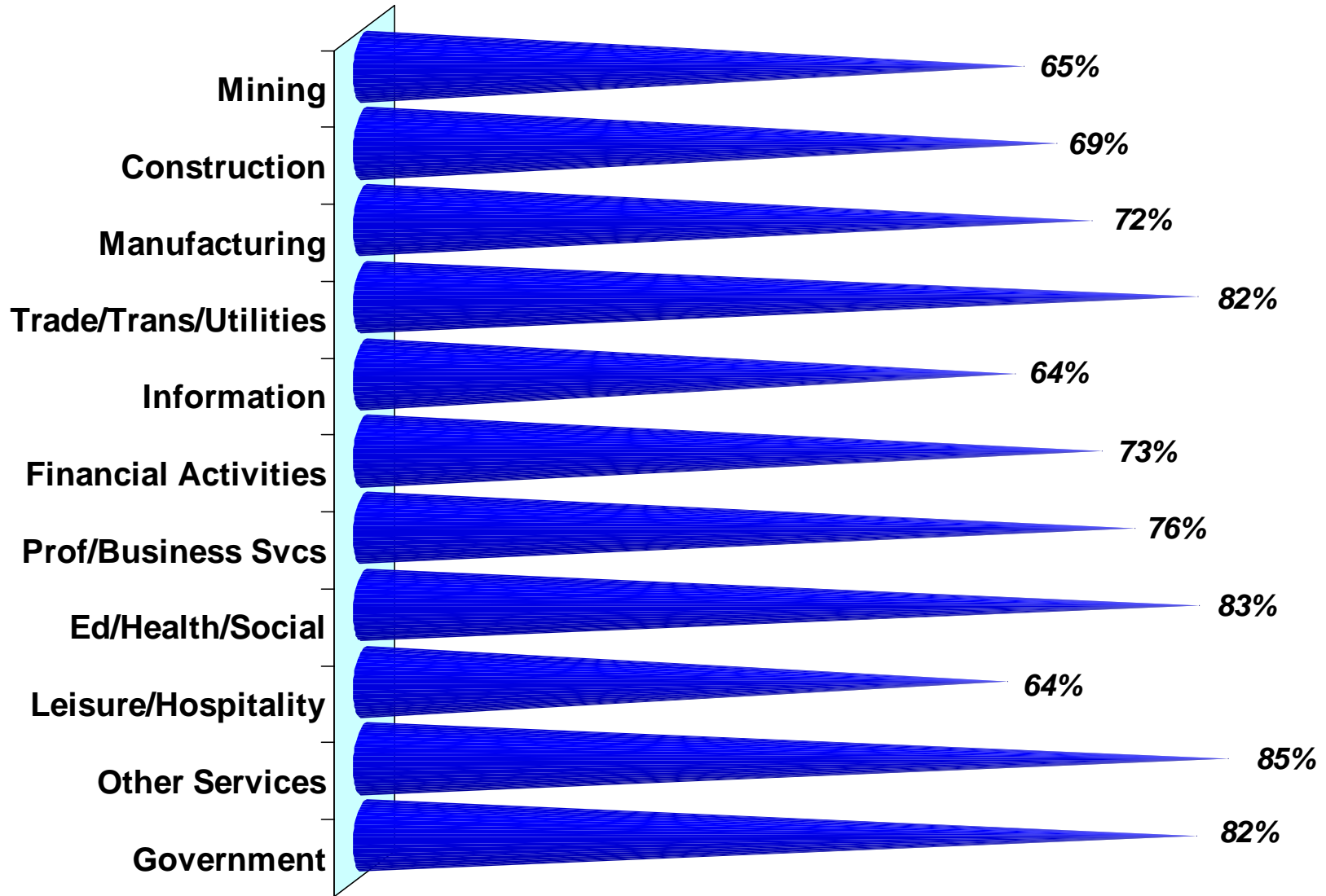

Sevier County 2006 Average Monthly Wage by Industry



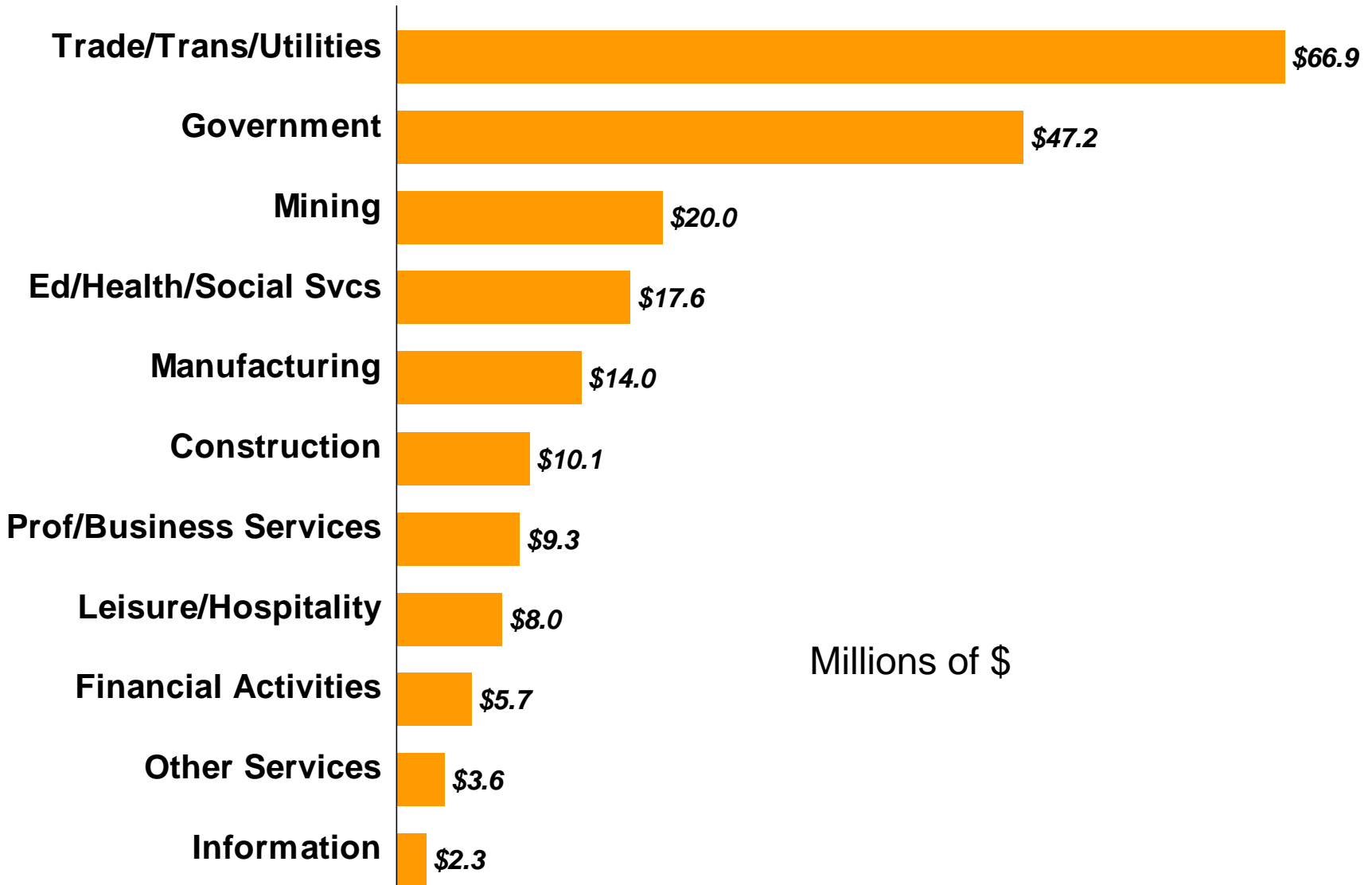

Sevier County 2006 Average Monthly Wage by Industry as a Percent of State



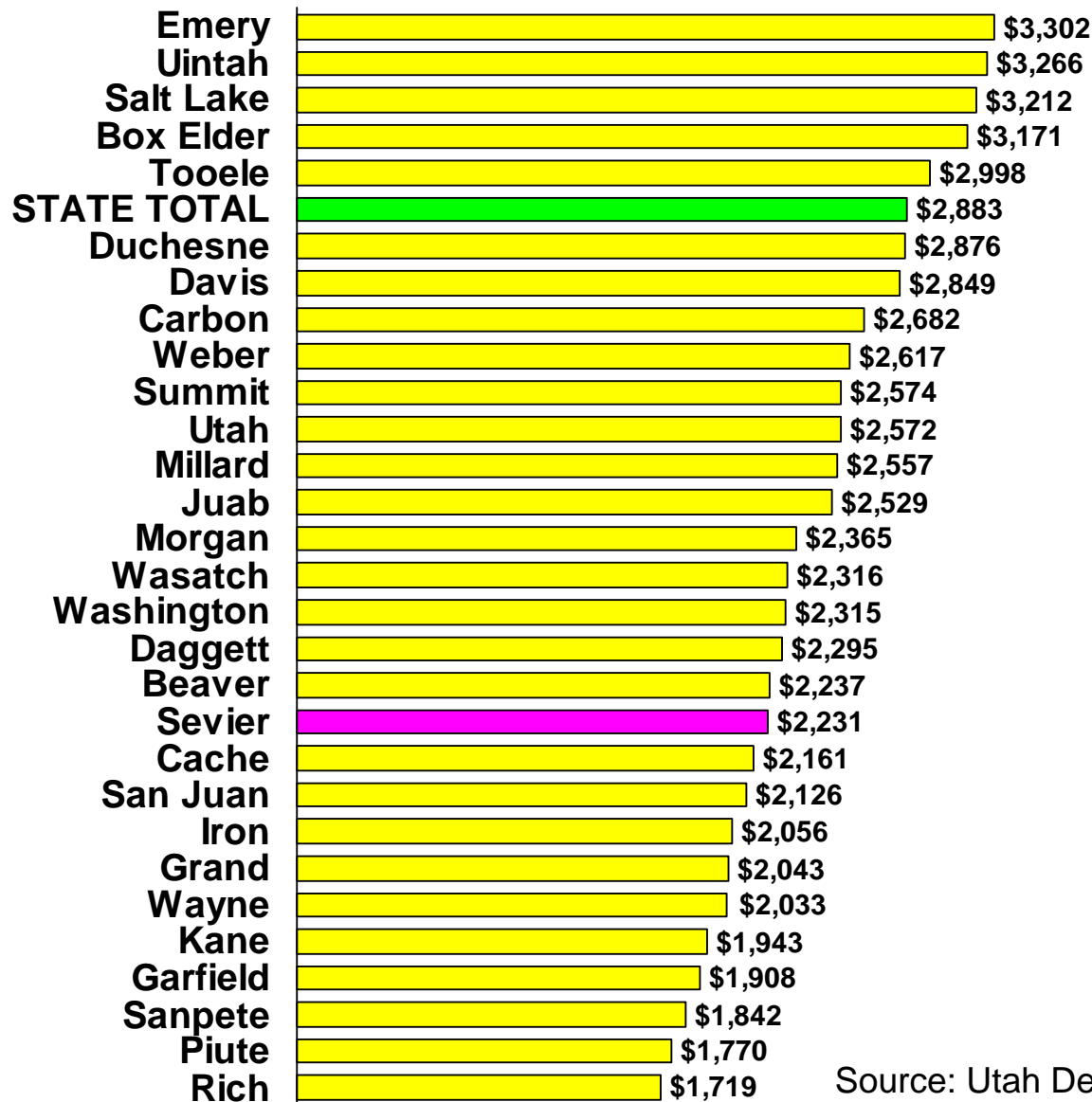

Sevier County 2006 Total Wages by Industry



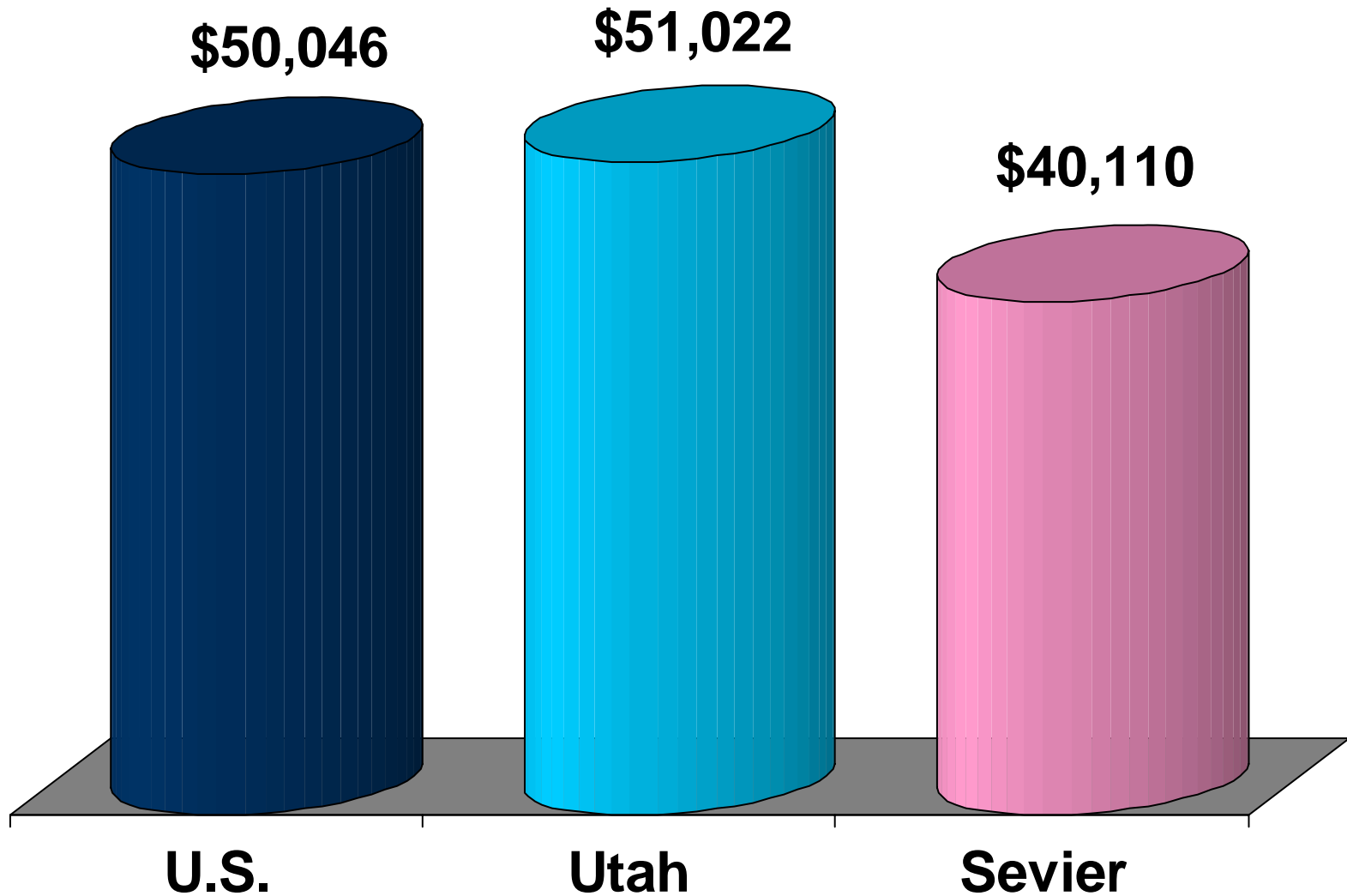

2006 Average Monthly Wage by County



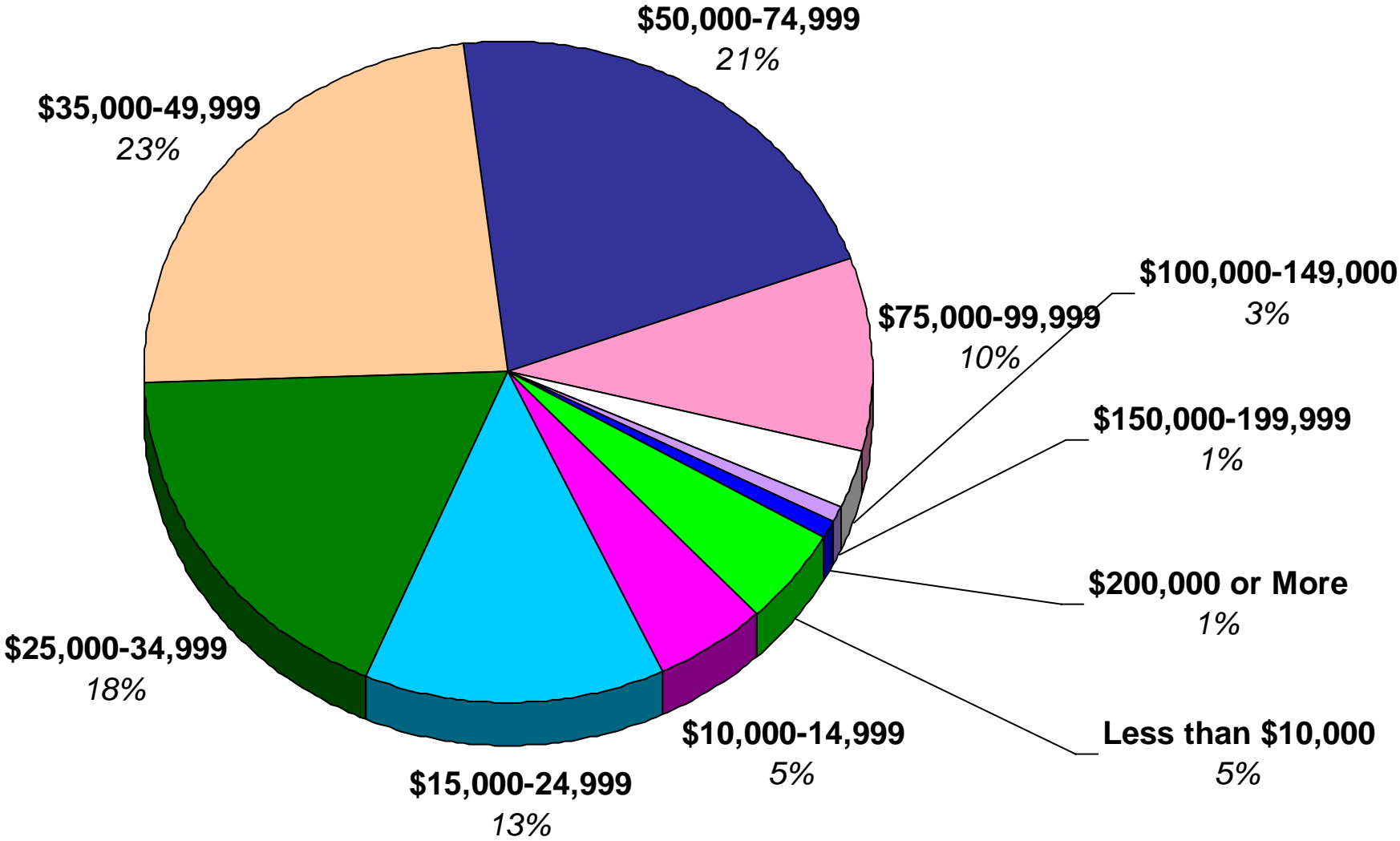

1999 Median Family Income



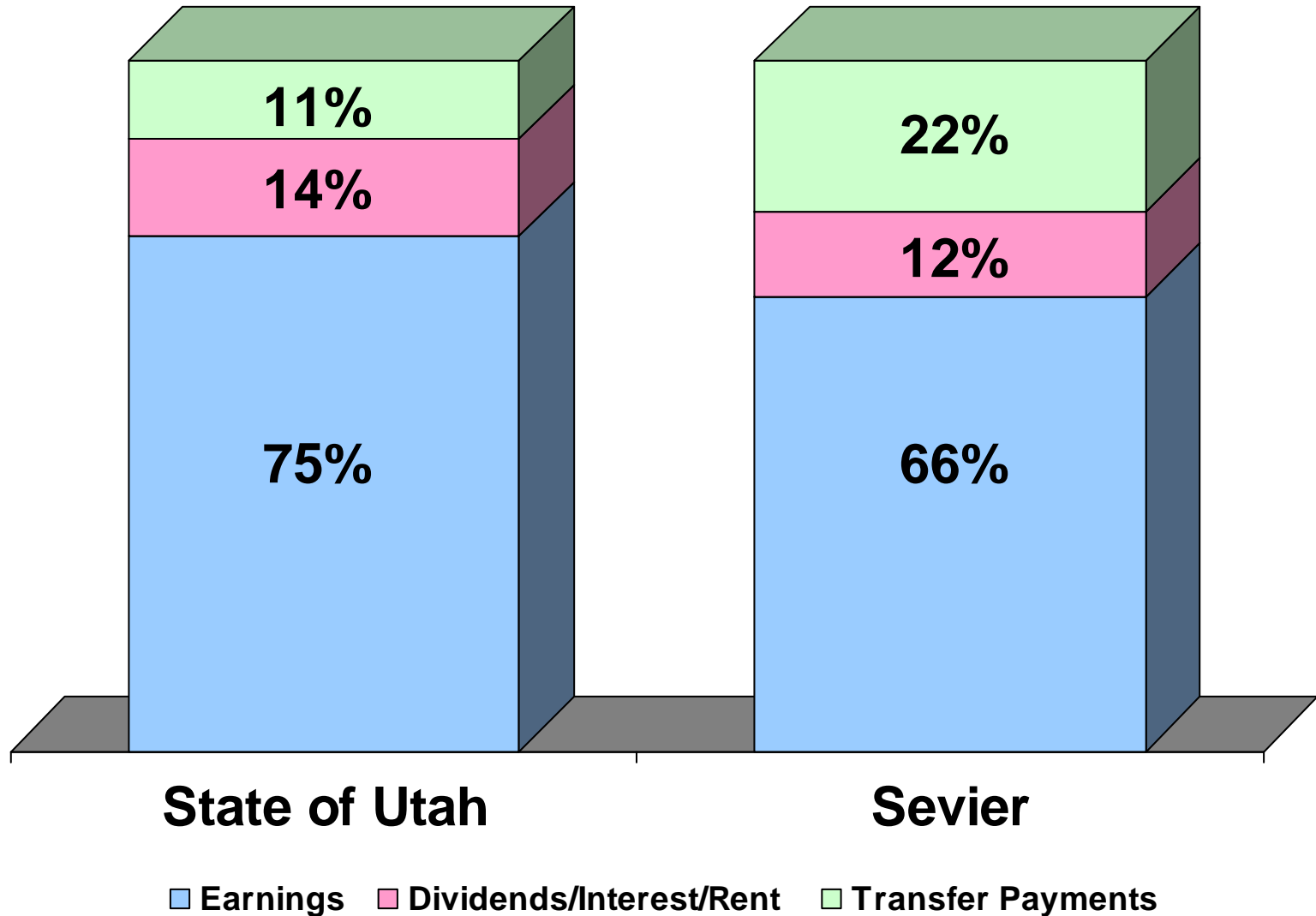

Sevier County 1999 Family Income



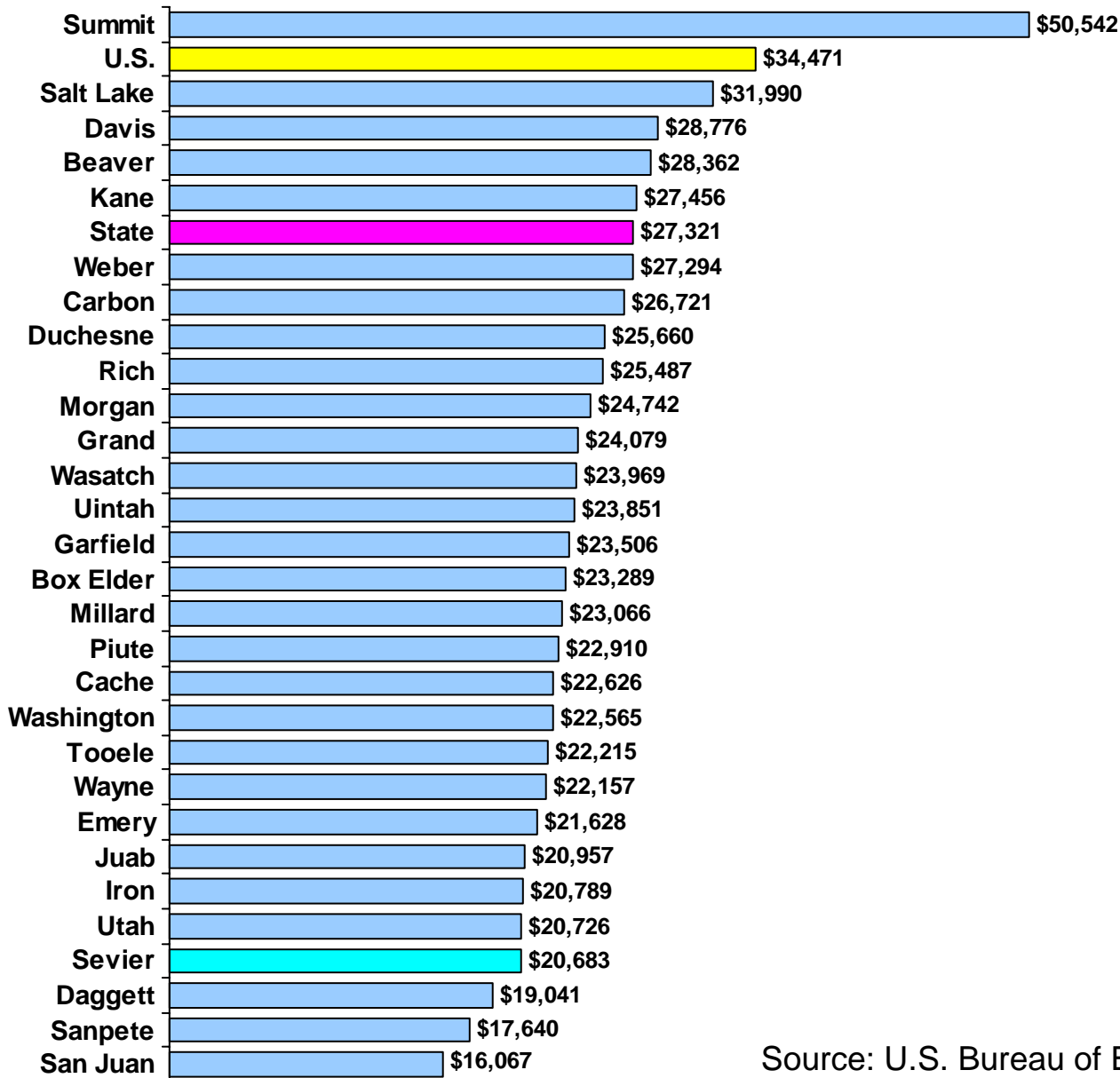

2005 Per Capita Personal Income by County



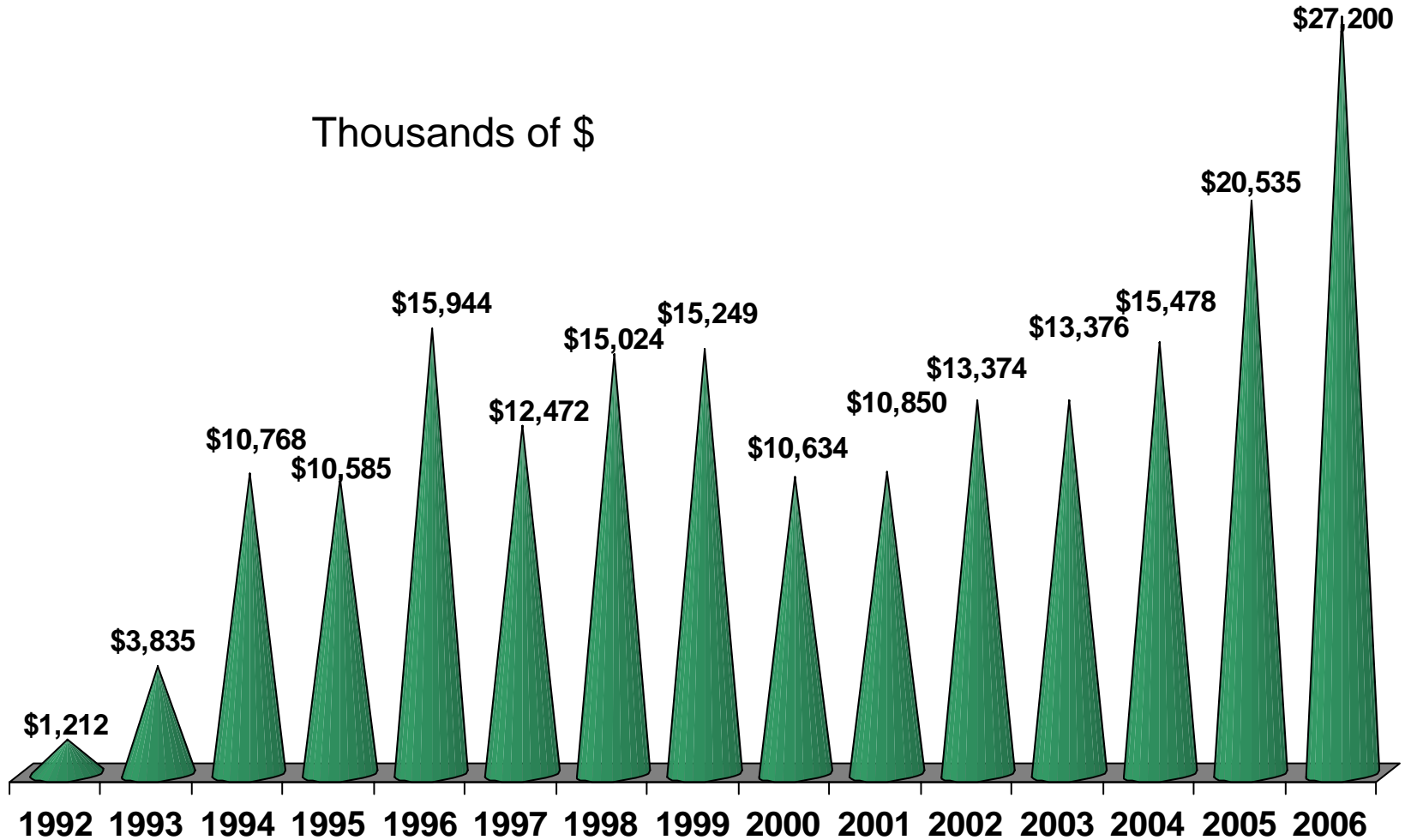

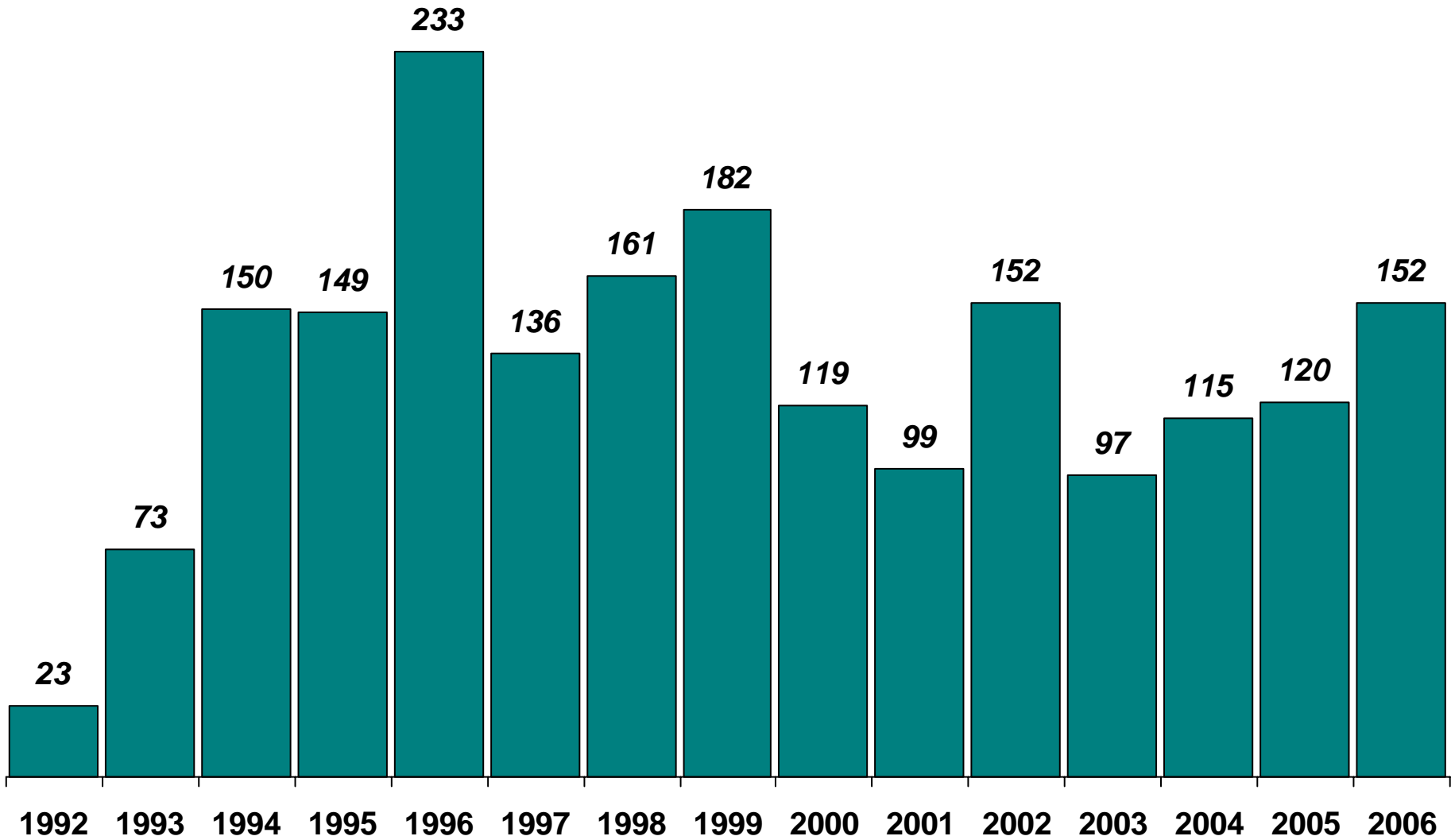
Sevier County New Residential Building Permit Valuation

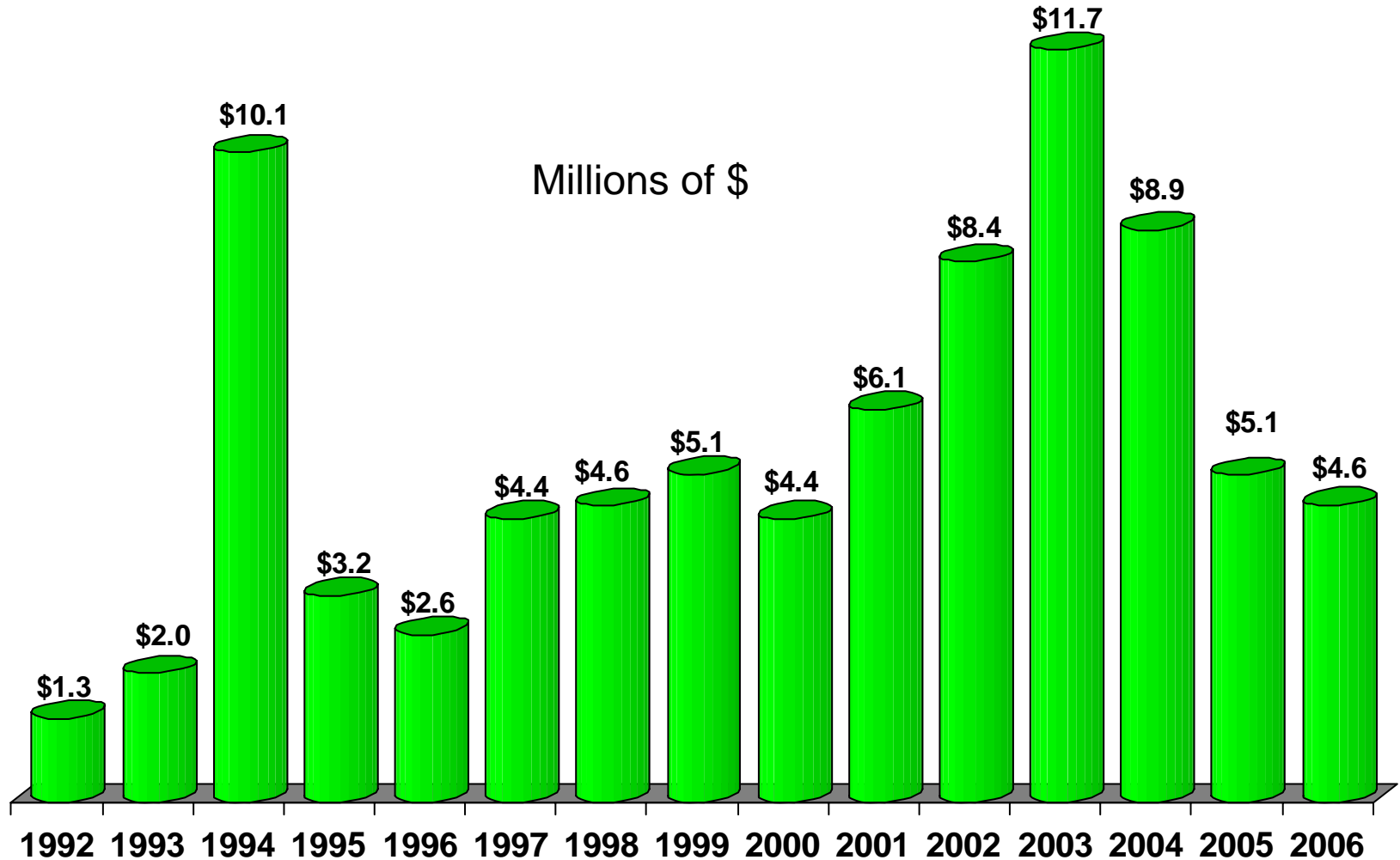

Sevier County-Permitted New Dwelling Units



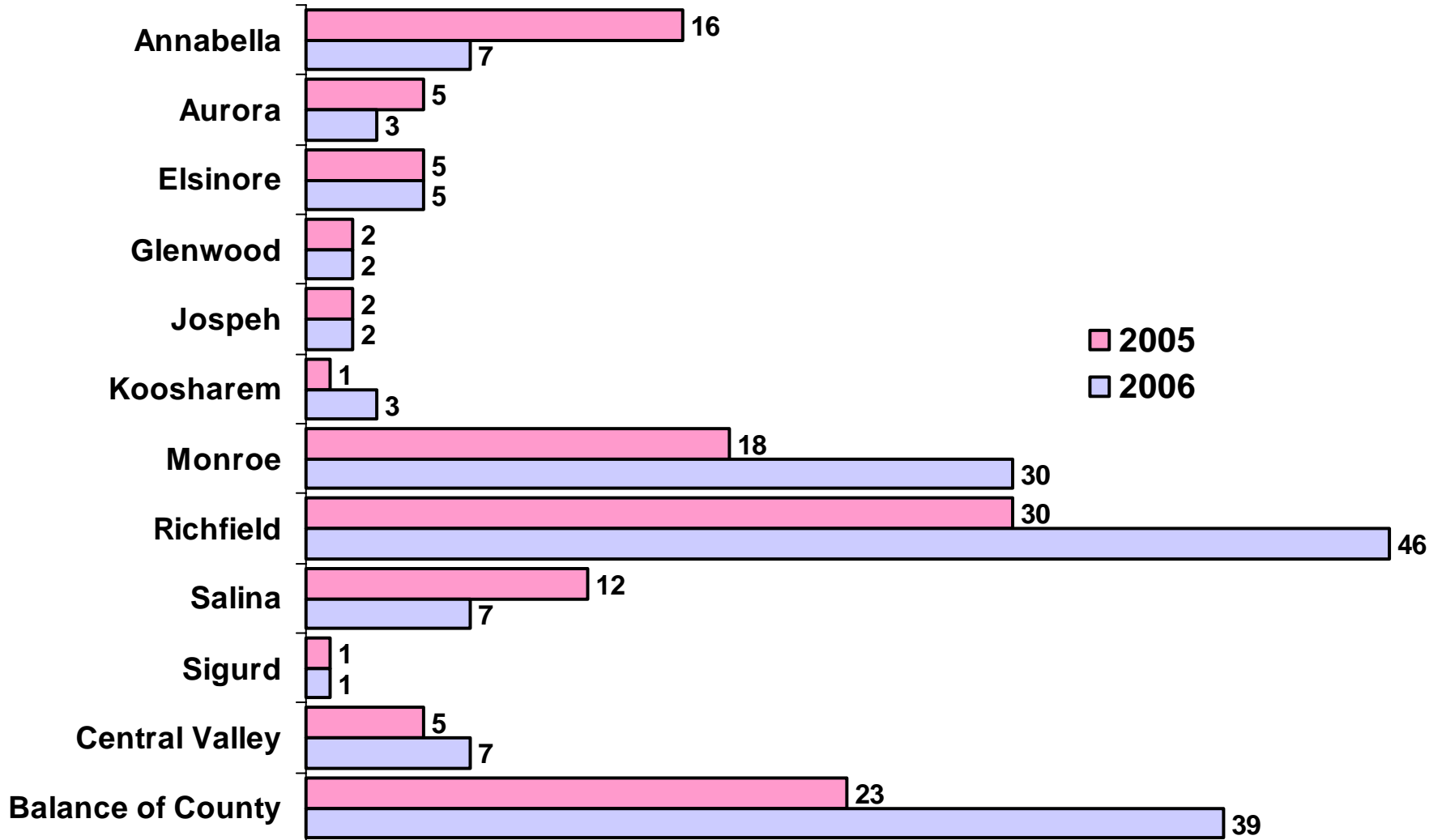

Sevier County New Nonresidential Building Permit Valuation



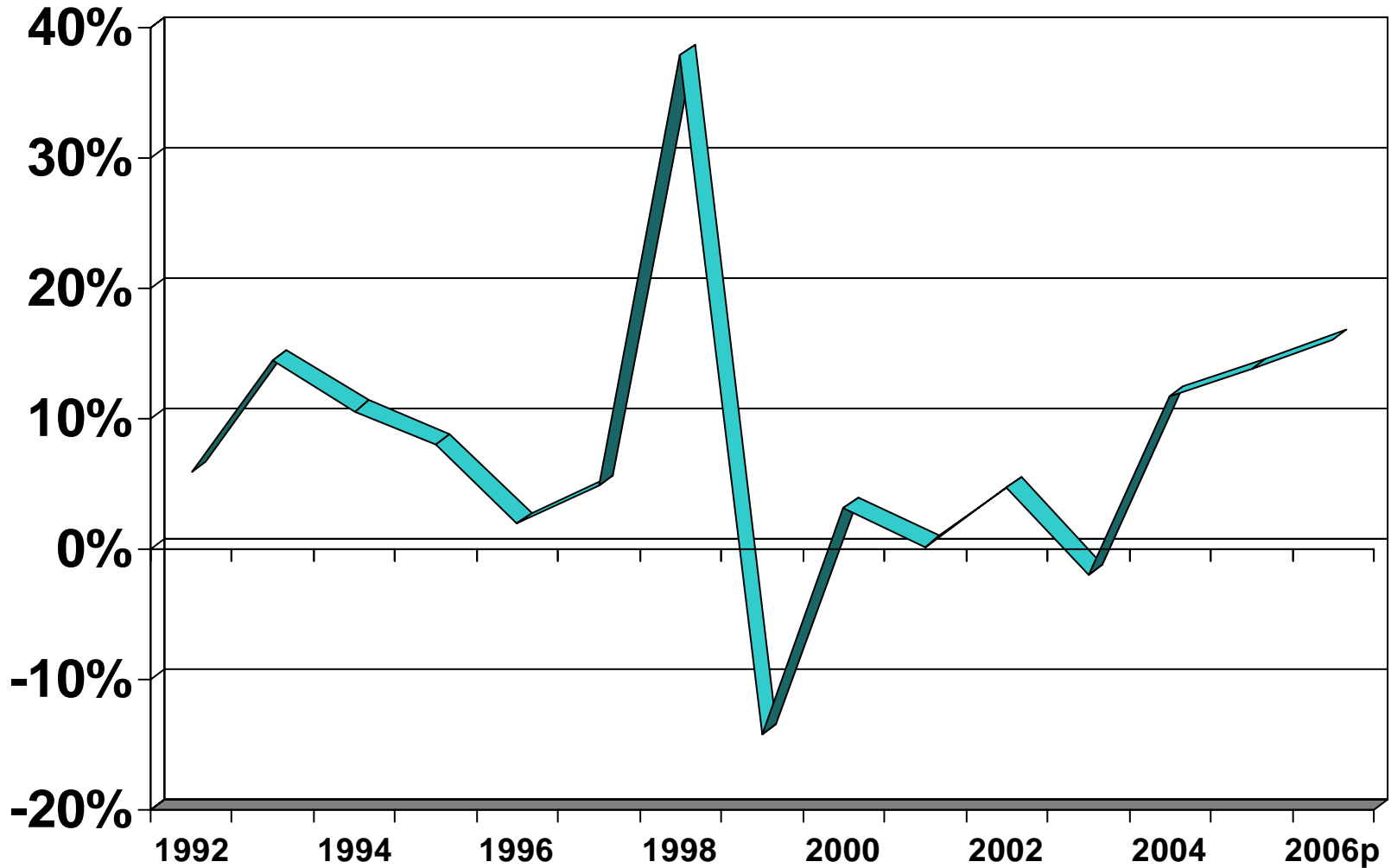

2005-2006 Sevier County-Permitted New Dwelling Units by Community



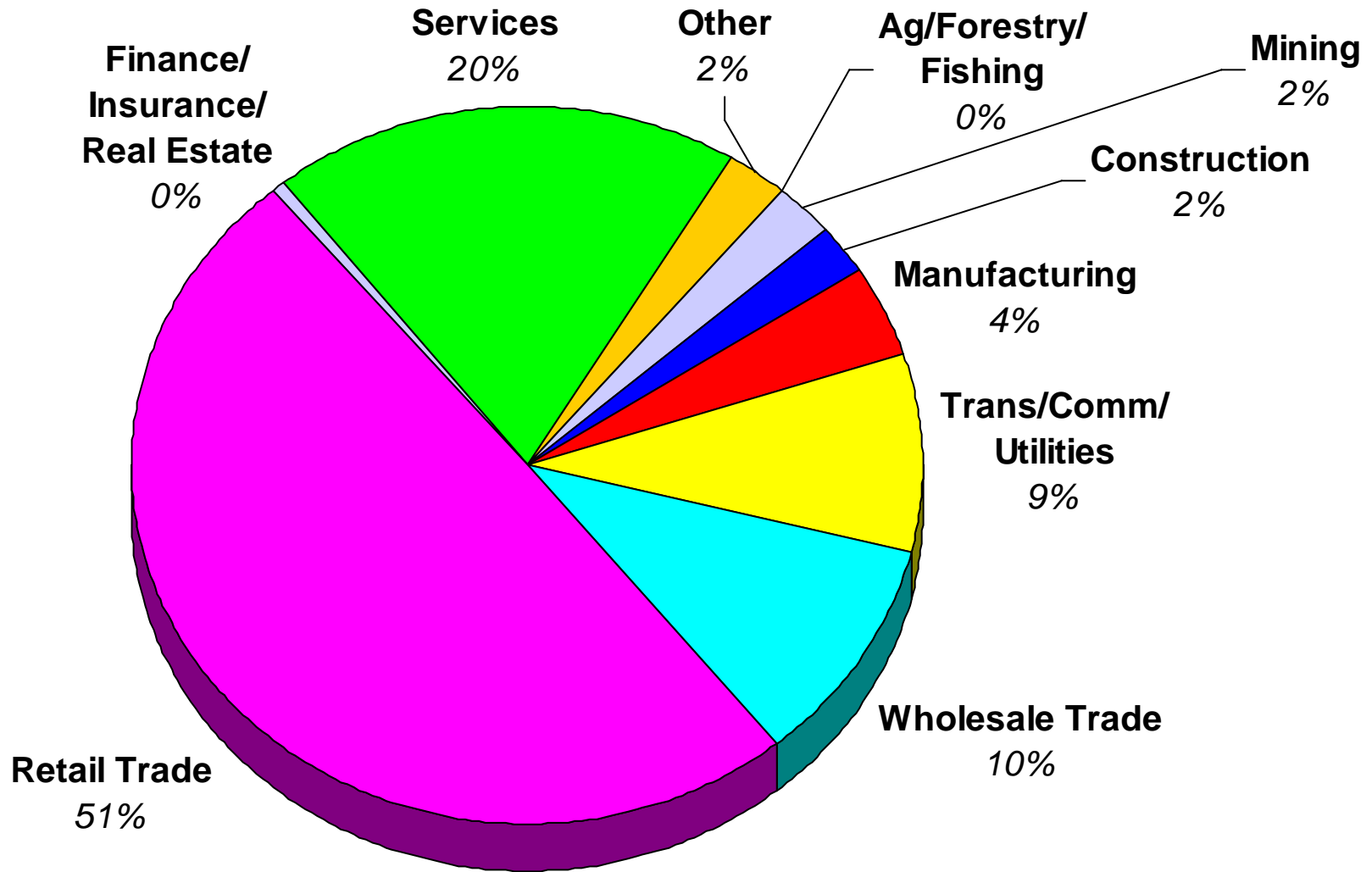

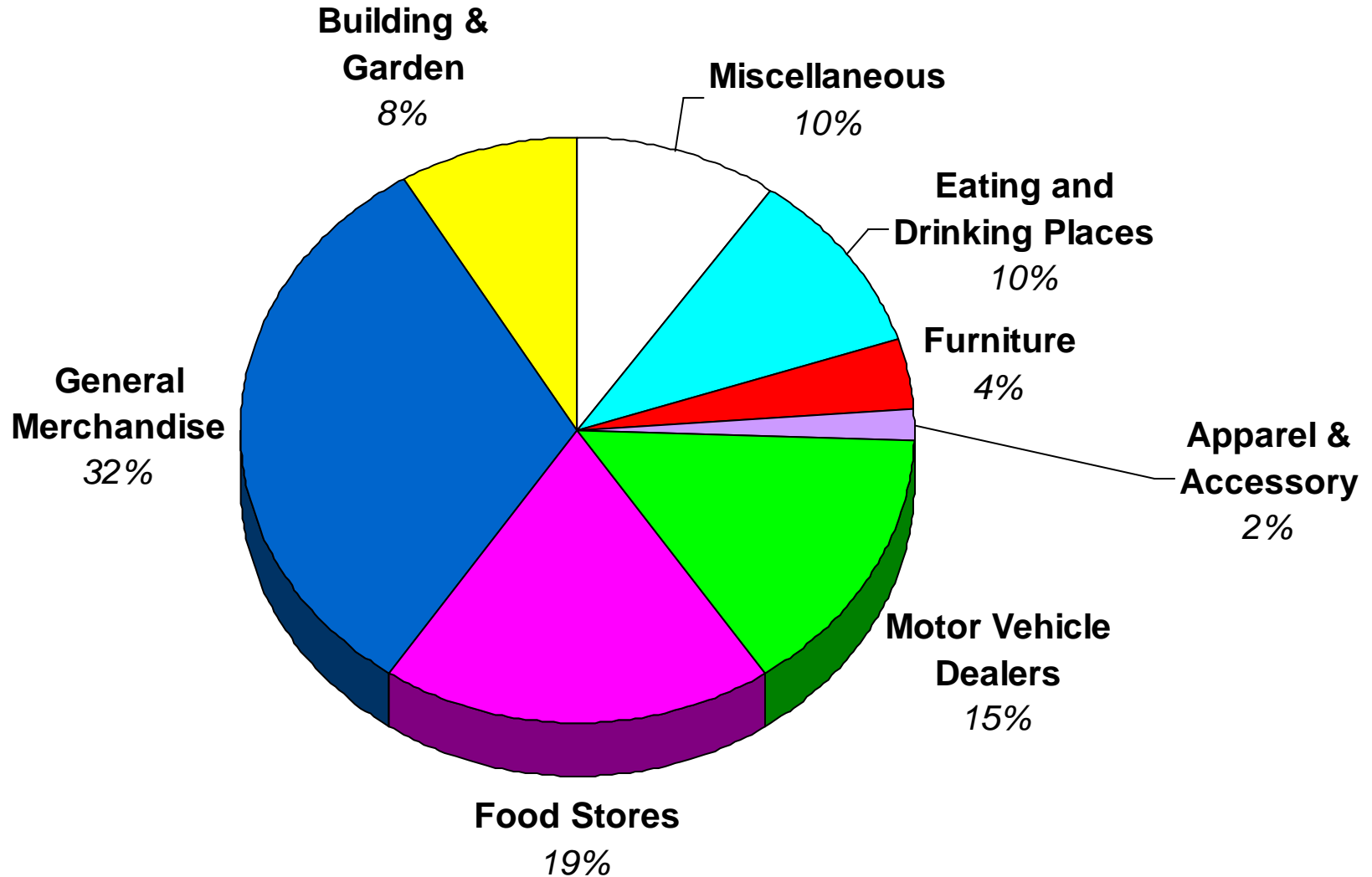
Sevier County 2005 Gross Taxable Sales by Industry
