## GENERAL PURPOSE

Operates ambulance to provide emergency medical transport. Provides lifting, CPR & First Aid

## SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the close to general supervision of the EMT Director or Squad Leader.

## SUPERVISION EXERCISED

None.

## ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Responds to emergency medical calls;
- Utilizes radio communications and "10-codes" to receive and transmit communications;
- Operates ambulance under emergency and normal conditions to transport patients to health care facilities, hospitals or other institutions;
- Operates AED or provides compressions during cardiopulmonary resuscitation;
- Applies bandages and dressing on minor soft tissue injuries as needed to stop bleeding;
- Lifts and carries patients from scene to ambulance according to established procedures;
- Assists with emergency childbirth;
- Performs preventative maintenance and daily inspection on assigned ambulance;
- Cleans exterior and interior of vehicle;
- Assures ambulance is properly stocked with necessary supplies;
- Apprises supervisor as needed to purchase replacement materials or schedule complex repairs.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

### 1. **Education and Experience:**

Graduation from high school or equivalent and some training in emergency medical services.

\*An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.

### 2. **Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:**

#### **Some knowledge of**

- First-aid and procedures;
- Interpersonal communication skills;
- Emergency vehicle operation.

#### **Ability to**

- Follow detailed verbal or written work instructions;
- Work in dangerous emergency situations;
- Perform strenuous physical labor;
- Communicate effectively, verbally and in writing;
- Perform under extreme weather conditions;
- Work on call and/or on shift work;
- Develop effective working relationships with supervisors, fellow employees, and the public.

### 3. **Special Qualifications:**

- Must be 18 years of age.
- Must possess a valid Utah State Driver's License.
- Must be or become First Aid, CPR, and AED Certified.
- Must be or become Emergency Vehicle Operator (EVO) certified.
- Resident of Sevier County.

**4. Work Environment:**

- Functions of the position periodically performed in an uncontrolled, hazardous environment, subject to all seasonal and weather extremes.
- Emergency response travel expected in normal course of performing duties.
- Many functions of the work pose high degree of hazard uncertainty.
- Potential exposure to blood borne pathogens, hazardous materials and chemicals at accident sites.
- Physical readiness and conditioning may be a condition of job retention.
- Various levels of mental application required, i.e., memory for details, emotional stability, discriminating thinking, creative problem solving.
- Continuous use of motor skills.
