

**COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**June 23, 2014**

Minutes of the regularly scheduled meeting of the Sevier County Commissioners held this twenty-third day of June, 2014. Meeting commenced at 1:30 p.m. with Commissioners Gary Mason, Gordon Topham, and Garth 'Tooter' Ogden in the Commission Chambers of the Sevier County Administration Building, 250 North Main, Richfield, Utah. Clerk/Auditor Steven C. Wall and Executive Director Malcolm Nash were also present.

County Attorney Dale Eyre was excused.

**Commission business:**

Commissioner Mason reported they had done the final walk through on the bike path. There are a few items left on the punch list, which should be finished up within the next couple of weeks. They are mostly small clean-up items, etc.

He then updated the Commissioners on the road projects that the Special Service District #1 is involved with at this time.

Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall then gave the Commissioners an update on the progress of the Primary Election. Reporting on the ballots received and plans for the vote centers for the Primary Election.

**Minutes of the June 9<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting approved:**

Minutes of the June 9<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting were reviewed and approved on a motion by Commissioner Mason, second Commissioner Ogden, unanimous.

**Abatement of rollback taxes on parcel 4-99-26 approved:**

The Commissioners then discussed the rollback taxes on a parcel that had been purchased by the County for road right-of-way on a road project being done near Sigurd along the Rocky Ford Canal Road. After discussion, Commissioner Mason moved to abate the rollback taxes of \$333.53 on parcel# 4-99-26, second Commissioner Ogden, unanimous.

**2014 Tax Rates adopted:**

Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall then reviewed with the Commissioners setting the tax rates to generate the dollars requested for the 2014 budget, noting that the certified total rate for the County and all funds would be 0.003113. After discussion, Commissioner Ogden moved to approve the proposed tax rates at a total of 0.003113 as recommended, second Commissioner Mason, unanimous.

**Resolution 2014-6-1 establishing Economic Development Enterprise zones adopted:**

Executive Director Malcolm Nash then reviewed with the Commissioners five proposed Economic Development Enterprise zones around the County, showing a map to the Commissioners noting where each was located, and reviewing resolution 2014-6-1. After review and discussion, Commissioner Mason moved to approve Resolution 2014-6-1 establishing the Economic Development Enterprise Zones as recommended, second Commissioner Ogden, unanimous.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
