

Candidate Qualifications

Utah Senate and Representative

Utah Constitution Article VI, Section 3,4,5,6; Utah Code 20A-9-201

- US Citizen at time of filing
- 25 years old at the filing deadline time
- 3 year resident of Utah at the filing deadline time
- 6 month resident of the district from which elected at the filing deadline time
- Qualified voter

No person holding any public office of profit or trust under authority of the United States, or of this State, shall be a member of the Legislature; provided, that appointments in the State Militia, and the offices of notary public, justice of the peace, United States Commissioner, and postmaster of the fourth class, shall not, within the meaning of this section, be considered offices of profit or trust.

County Commission

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-53-202; 20A-9-201

- US Citizen at time of filing
- Registered voter for at least one year before the date of the election
- Be a registered voter of the county which the member represents
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election

County Clerk/Auditor, Recorder, Treasurer

Utah Code 17-16-1; 20A-9-201

- US Citizen at time of filing
- Registered voter for at least one year
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election

County Assessor

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-17-2; 20A-9-201

- US Citizen at time of filing
- A registered voter for at least one year
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election
- Shall be a state-registered appraiser within 36 months from the day on which his term of office begins

County Sheriff

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-22-1.5; 20A-9-201

- US Citizen at time of filing
- A registered voter for at least one year
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election
- At the time of filing:
 - Has successfully met the requirement of the Peace Officer Training and Certification Act; or
 - Has passed a certification examination and qualified to be certified as devined in Section 53-13-103

- Present a POST certification with the declaration of candidacy and be certified as a correctional officer. 17-22-1.5

County Attorney

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-18-5; 20A-9-201

- US Citizen at time of filing
- An attorney licensed to practice law in Utah who is an active member in good standing of the Utah State Bar
- A registered voter in the county
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election
- If there is no qualified attorney residing in the county, or a qualified attorney does not file, the county commission will fill the office by appointment

Local School Board Member

Utah Code 20A-9-201; 20A-14-202

- US Citizen at time of filing
- Resident in the school representative district from which elected for at least one year before the election
- Qualified and registered elector (registered voter 20A-2-101 & 104) of the school representative district from which elected
- Non-partisan

Justice Court Judge

Utah Code 20A-12-201; 78A-7-201

- A citizen of the United State
- 25 years of age or older
- A resident of Utah for at least three years immediately preceding his appointment
- A resident of the county in which the court is located or an adjacent county for at least six months immediately preceding appointment; and
- A qualified voter of the county in which the judge resides
- Be an incumbent Justice Court Judge.
